### PENTECOST SUNDAY, MAY 24th, 2015

Greetings brothers and sisters in Christ! This weekend we celebrate the wonderful feast of Pentecost. Recall when Mary and the Apostles were in the upper room and the Holy Spirit came upon them and they went forth boldly proclaiming the Gospel. Archbishop Luis Martinez in his book *The Sanctifier*, said that devotion to the Holy Spirit is a regular part of the Christian life, it is not just for certain times or only when praying a novena, just as devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary is a constant part of our spiritual life, not just at certain times

When the Holy Spirit came upon Mary, Jesus was formed, hence Archbishop Martinez comments that when the Holy Spirit and Mary are in our lives, Jesus is formed within us. When Jesus is formed within us, we begin to sing the hymn of praise to the Father, which is what Jesus' life was about. We join in this hymn especially at Mass, and when our relationship with the Holy Spirit and the Blessed Virgin Mary grows, our whole life becomes a hymn of praise to the Father! This is more than nice sounding theology, this is real life! We can call on the Holy Spirit at all times, when driving, when working, when socializing, when preparing supper. The more we become attentive to the working of the Holy Spirit in our lives, the more we will be able to respond to His inspirations!
