# What is expected of you as a parishioner of Most Blessed Sacrament Catholic Church:

### To Worship/Pray:

In John's Gospel (6:55), Jesus says: "My flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink." The crowd answered him saying: "This teaching is hard" and asked, "Who can accept it?" Jesus then said to the Twelve, "Do you also want to leave?" Simon Peter answered him, "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life." (Jn 6:67-68) Every Sunday, we gather in community to celebrate this truth in the Eucharist. Unless one is travelling or ill, we expect all parishioners to join in this communal Mass weekly. Our memorial of the Lord's Day nourishes us in Word and Sacrament and feeds us for the journey. Here we also fulfill our call to worship the Creator and receive the grace necessary to increase in holiness.

#### To Grow:

God wills us to become disciples of Jesus. (Jn 15:8) The very meaning of discipleship is that we are constantly "learning". This lifelong task of discerning and discovering is necessary for spiritual growth. We expect every member of Most Blessed Sacrament to participate in at least one program of faith formation annually. Together, by helping one another remember this commitment, we become a healthy faith community.

#### To Serve:

In Mark's Gospel, Jesus says: "The Son of Man came not to be served but to serve." (Mk 10:45) The essence of Christian life is to imitate Christ in service to God and one another, both individually and corporately. We believe that each person has been given a unique gift to offer for the sake of building the Kingdom of God. We expect every parishioner to serve in some capacity by being involved in at least one ministry.

#### To Connect:

"Two are better than one...if the one falls, the other will help the fallen one. Where one alone may be overcome, two together can resist. A three-ply cord is not easily broken." (Eccl 4:9-12) The Church is a community of believers who are accountable both to and for one another. We expect every parishioner to make an intentional connection to build our community in response to the realization that each person is integral and necessary to the life of the parish.

#### To Give:

Deuteronomy instructs each of us to give "with his or her own gift, in proportion to the blessing which the LORD, your God, has given to you." (Dt 16:17) We expect every parishioner to give in proportion to what they have received from God. We give in order to extend gratitude to God acknowledging that all we have is a gift. This offering is an integral part of our Sunday worship as we offer to God through Christ the entirety of our lives in the Eucharist.
