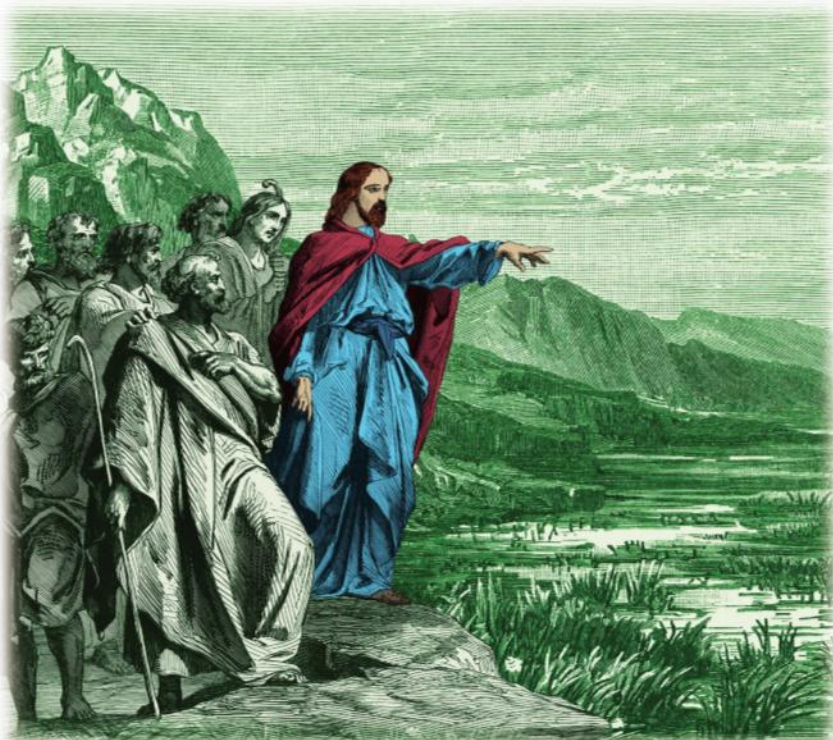

MESSAGE FROM ARCHBISHOP GUSTAVO



Ordination to the priesthood of Christ is more than a ritual. It is a covenant, formed in the image of Christ, the New Covenant between God and humanity. The rewards of covenant life are the fruits of the Holy Spirit. Charity that reaches beyond comfort. Joy that shines through suffering.

Peace that calms anxious hearts. Patience that endures the long wait. Kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control – these marks of the Spirit sanctify ministry and bear witness to the living God. A genuine prophet does not proclaim mere words but embodies God's compassion, denouncing injustice and proclaiming good news without fear. Yet we must remain vigilant. False prophets abound, offering a veneer of piety while their lives tell another story. If priest's lives fail to reflect the self-giving love of Christ, their words remain empty echoes. This caution applies to every priest and every believer. We are called to constant conversion, allowing the Holy Spirit to prune whatever in us resists the flow of divine love. May the ministry of priests draw others into the same covenant of grace, nourished by Word and sacrament. We entrust all that we are and all that we hope to Our Lady of Guadalupe, who leads us to her Son.

MEDITATION OF THE SCRIPTURES



There seems to be a lot of rejoicing in today's readings. Isaiah talks about rejoicing with Jerusalem. The Gospel shows the disciples rejoicing when they came back from visiting towns to tell about the Kingdom. St. Paul is happy to

be suffering for Christ. So what is the reason for such joy? The readings make clear that it is not a result of our efforts. Isaiah writes that "the Lord's power shall be known to his servants" (Isaiah 66:14). Jesus tells his disciples not to rejoice that they cast out demons, but "because your names are written in heaven" (Luke 10:20). In other words, we are to rejoice over all the Lord has done for us, not what we have done for him. Does that sound like false humility? No; when we do anything for others, we can honestly say that God does the real work. Knowing that frees us from expecting everyone to be happy, everything we do for others to be successful. Instead of being discouraged when we seem to fail, we can trust that God's plan is working in ways we just can't see. St. Paul has a similar theme in the second reading. You would think he would be proud of all the converts he made, or the people he cured. He boasts only about his suffering because that is how he is most like Jesus. He sees all of his accomplishments as the work of God. All three readings remind us that what changes our lives and changes the world is not how hard we work, or how holy we are; what really makes the difference is how much God loves us. That is the real reason to rejoice. -Tom Schmidt

MENSAJE DEL ARZOBISPO GUSTAVO



La ordenación al sacerdocio de Cristo es más que un ritual. Es un pacto, formado a imagen de Cristo, el Nuevo Pacto entre Dios y la humanidad. Las recompensas de la vida de convenio son los frutos del Espíritu Santo. Caridad que va más allá de la comodidad. Alegría que brilla a través del sufrimiento. Paz que calma los corazones ansiosos. Paciencia que aguanta la larga espera. La bondad, la bondad, la fidelidad, la mansedumbre, el dominio propio: estas marcas del Espíritu santifican el ministerio y dan testimonio del Dios vivo. Un profeta genuino no proclama meras palabras, sino que encarna la compasión de Dios, denunciando la injusticia y proclamando la buena noticia sin miedo. Sin embargo, debemos permanecer vigilantes. Abundan los falsos profetas, que ofrecen un barniz de piedad mientras sus vidas cuentan otra historia. Si la vida de los sacerdotes no refleja el amor abnegado de Cristo, sus palabras siguen siendo ecos vacíos. Esta precaución se aplica a cada sacerdote y a cada creyente. Estamos llamados a la conversión constante, permitiendo que el Espíritu Santo poda todo lo que en nosotros se resiste al flujo del amor divino. Que el ministerio de los sacerdotes atraiga a los demás a la misma alianza de gracia, alimentada por la Palabra y los sacramentos. Encomendamos todo lo que somos y todo lo que esperamos a Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe, quien nos conduce a su Hijo.

REFLEXIÓN DE LAS ESCRITURAS

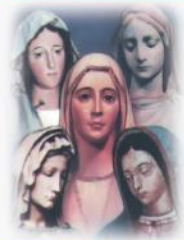


Parece que hay mucho regocijo en las lecturas de hoy. Isaías habla de regocijarse con Jerusalén. El Evangelio muestra a los discípulos regocijándose cuando regresaban de visitar pueblos para hablarles sobre el Reino. San Pablo está feliz de estar sufriendo por Cristo. Entonces, ¿cuál es la razón de tanta alegría? Las lecturas dejan claro que no es el resultado de nuestros esfuerzos. Isaías escribe que "Y los siervos del Señor conocerán su poder" (Isaías 66,14). Jesús les dice a sus discípulos que no se alegren por expulsar demonios, sino "de que sus nombres están escritos en el cielo" (Lucas 10,20). En otras palabras, debemos regocijarnos por todo lo que el Señor ha hecho por nosotros, no por lo que hemos hecho por él. ¿Suena eso a la humildad falsa? No. Cuando hacemos algo por los demás, podemos decir honestamente que Dios hace el verdadero trabajo. Saber eso nos libera de esperar que todos sean felices, de que todo lo que hagamos por los demás tenga éxito. En lugar de desanimarnos cuando parece que fracasamos, podemos confiar en que el plan de Dios está funcionando de maneras que no podemos ver. San Pablo tiene un tema semejante en la segunda lectura. Uno pensaría que estaría orgulloso de todas las conversiones que ha hecho o de las personas que ha curado. Presume sólo de su sufrimiento porque así es como más se parece a Jesús. Ve todos sus logros como obra de Dios. Las tres lecturas nos recuerdan que lo que cambia nuestras vidas y cambia el mundo no es cuánto nos esforzamos o cuán santos seamos; lo que realmente marca la diferencia es cuánto nos ama Dios. 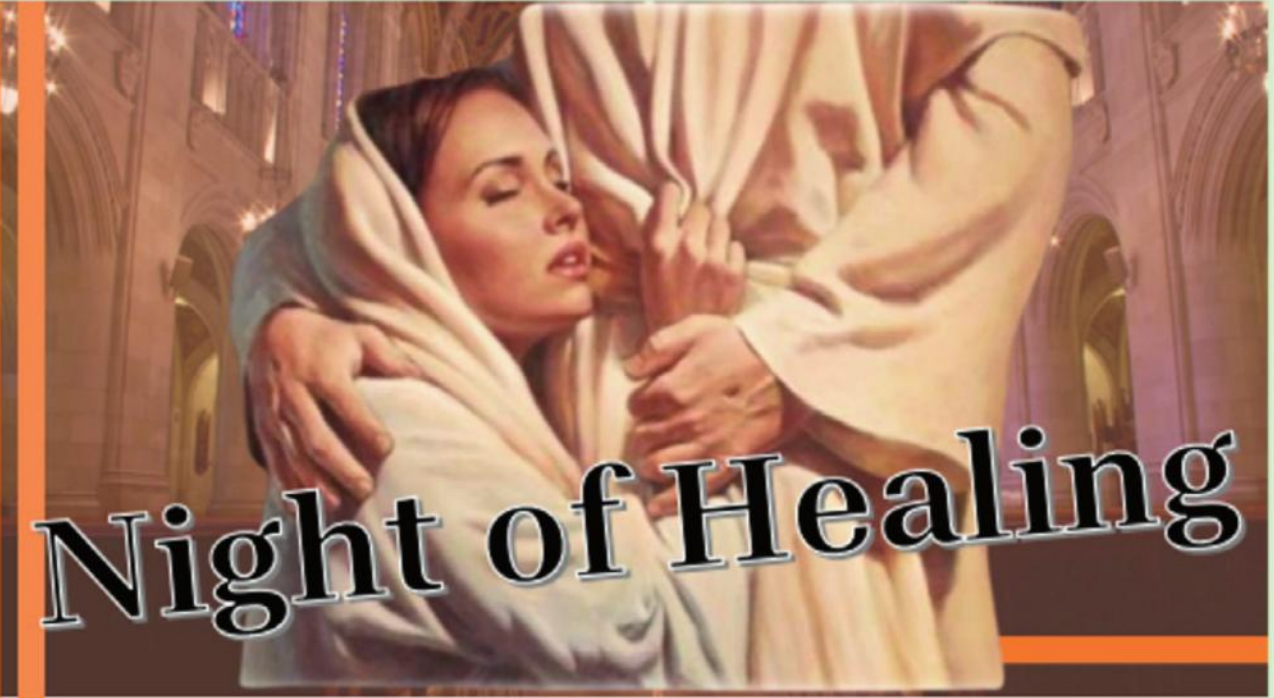

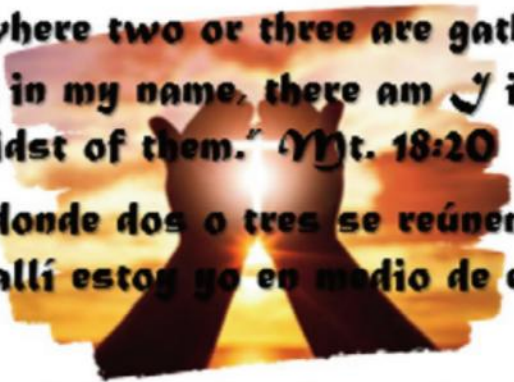
