

MESSAGE FROM ARCHBISHOP GUSTAVO



Brothers and sisters, we hold before God more than 100 souls claimed by the July 4 flood in the Hill Country. Their names have been released—an invitation to pray for each beloved child of God by name. Though we may not have known them personally, we can honor them in our hearts and at our altars. Shelters offer safety, food, and care; churches welcome all for Mass, various kinds of prayer, vigils, and pastoral support. We honor the courage and sacrifice of first responders and all who are serving in love. We are grateful to Pope Leo XIV, who has joined in our mourning as he expressed his “sincere condolences to all the families who have lost loved ones, in particular their daughters, who were at the summer camp, in the disaster caused by flooding of the Guadalupe River in Texas.” At this moment, many questions press upon us: Why did this happen? How do we move forward? Our first duty is to be present—to survivors clinging to hope, to grieving parents, to every family wrestling with sorrow. In gentle companionship, we begin to process what we have lost. Hopefully, we will continue to see a resurgence of love, care, and solidarity. May the Holy Spirit console us and may Our Lady of Guadalupe guide our steps.

MEDITATION OF THE SCRIPTURES



The Gospel for this Sunday can sometimes give the impression that Jesus favored Mary over Martha. But if they had both sat down to listen, there would have been no dinner to serve to Jesus.

He saw that Mary was content to listen to him, so Martha could have been content to prepare the meal for him. Remember the first reading, in which Abraham insisted on serving the visitors, whom he came to recognize as the Lord and two angels. He was rewarded with the assurance that he would soon have a son. So simple acts of hospitality can also be how people can welcome the Lord into their homes. When we welcome someone into our homes as a visitor, or into our lives as a friend, we are also welcoming Christ. When we get to know someone better, we are also getting to know Christ. And what about that “better part” that Mary had chosen? Are we sometimes like Martha, with too many things on our minds to be aware of the Lord? Sometimes we can’t avoid the distractions that are part of life. But if we keep the Lord on our minds we may be able to see which are distractions to be put aside, and which are opportunities to serve the Lord in a different way. As we spend more time with the Lord in prayer, we begin to experience God’s peace, which gives us the ability to choose the better part. Tom Schmidt

MENSAJE DEL ARZOBISPO GUSTAVO



Hermanos y hermanas, tenemos ante Dios más de 100 almas reclamadas por la inundación del 4 de julio en Hill Country. Sus nombres han sido publicados, una invitación a orar por cada hijo amado de Dios por su nombre. Aunque no los hayamos conocido personalmente, podemos honrarlos en nuestro corazón y en nuestros altares. Los refugios ofrecen seguridad, alimentos y atención; Las iglesias dan la bienvenida a todos para la Misa, varios tipos de oración, vigiliyas y apoyo pastoral. Honramos el valor y el sacrificio de los Primeros auxilios y de todos los que sirven con amor. Agradecemos al Papa León XIV, que se ha unido a nuestro luto al expresar sus "sinceras condolencias a todas las familias que han perdido a sus seres queridos, en particular a sus hijas, que estaban en el campamento de verano, en el desastre causado por la crecida del río Guadalupe en Texas". En este momento, muchas preguntas nos apremian: ¿Por qué sucedió esto? ¿Cómo avanzamos? Nuestro primer deber es estar presentes: a los sobrevivientes que se aferran a la esperanza, a los padres afligidos, a todas las familias que luchan con el dolor. El Evangelio de este domingo puede dar a veces la impresión de que Jesús favoreció a María sobre Marta. Pero si ambos se hubieran sentado a escuchar, no habría habido cena para servirle a Jesús. Él vio que María estaba contenta de escucharlo, por lo que Marta podría haberse contentado con prepararle la comida. Recuerden la primera lectura, en la que Abraham insistió en servir a los visitantes, a quienes llegó a reconocer como el Señor y dos ángeles. Fue recompensado con la seguridad de que pronto tendría un hijo. Por eso, los actos sencillos de hospitalidad también pueden ser la forma en que las personas pueden dar la bienvenida al Señor en sus hogares. Cuando damos la bienvenida a alguien en nuestros hogares como visitante, o en nuestras vidas como amigo, también estamos dando la bienvenida a Cristo. Cuando llegamos a conocer mejor a alguien, también estamos llegando a conocer a Cristo. ¿Y qué pasa con esa "parte mejor" que María había elegido? ¿Somos a veces como Marta, con demasiadas cosas en la mente como para estar atentos al Señor? A veces no podemos evitar las distracciones que son parte de la vida. Pero si tenemos presente al Señor, podremos ver cuáles son las distracciones que debemos dejar de lado y cuáles son oportunidades para servir al Señor de una manera diferente. A medida que pasamos más tiempo con el Señor en la oración, comenzamos a experimentar la paz de Dios, que nos da la capacidad de elegir la mejor parte. -Tom Schmidt



Parish Support Line

A service to the parishes that gives pastors a resource to help individuals and families that turn to them in need of financial assistance.

Pastors or their designees can call the Parish Support Line to request resources are available through Catholic Charities. Most often, pastors seek the help of Catholic Charities when a parishioner finds themselves in one of the following emergency situations:

- Family loses their home and belongings to a fire.
- Household breadwinner loses a job.
- An individual becomes ill or injured and can no longer provide for the family.
- A loved one is facing deportation and needs immigration services.
- An individual needs crisis counseling due to the victimization of a crime or severe depression.
- An individual is in need of emergency financial assistance.
