



MESSAGE FROM ARCHBISHOP GUSTAVO



I would like to share some reflections on our prayer for vocations – those called to serve God’s harvest – and particularly on lay ecclesial ministers who, like the first disciples, teach, shepherd, and heal in Christ’s name. The heart of our vocation prayer is not merely asking God for workers but committing ourselves to seek and support those He calls, men and women who will stand among the people, proclaiming the Gospel in word and deed. Committed missionary disciples build up the community by coordinating catechesis, guiding prayer groups, visiting the sick, and forming disciples. In prayerful solidarity, we recognize that lay ministers pioneer fresh expressions of ministry, responding to emerging needs in our parishes, schools, and social outreach. Let us ask the Lord of the harvest to raise up men and women of prayer and service: catechists who spread the light of Scripture; pastoral coordinators who foster communion; pastoral musicians who lift hearts to heaven; and all lay ministers who enrich the Body of Christ. May our persistent prayer yield abundant workers, each bearing Christ’s light to our world.


FAITH FORMATION—VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL



BIENVENIDOS A LA VIDA PARROQUIAL DE SAN GREGORIO MAGNO

SECCIÓN EN ESPAÑOL

MENSAJE DEL ARZOBISPO GUSTAVO



Quisiera compartir algunas reflexiones sobre nuestra oración por las vocaciones, las llamadas a servir a la mies de Dios, y en particular sobre los ministros eclesiales laicos que, como los primeros discípulos, enseñan, pastorean y sanan en el nombre de Cristo. El corazón de nuestra oración vocacional no es simplemente pedir a Dios obreros, sino comprometernos a buscar y apoyar a aquellos que Él llama, hombres y mujeres que estarán en medio de la gente, proclamando el Evangelio con palabras y obras. Los discípulos misioneros comprometidos construyen la comunidad coordinando la catequesis, guiando grupos de oración, visitando a los enfermos y formando discípulos. En solidaridad con la oración, reconocemos que los ministros laicos son pioneros en nuevas expresiones de ministerio, respondiendo a las necesidades emergentes en nuestras parroquias, escuelas y alcance social. Pidamos al Dueño de la mies que suscite hombres y mujeres de oración y de servicio: catequistas que difundan la luz de la Escritura; coordinadores pastorales que promueven la comunión; músicos pastorales que elevan los corazones al cielo; y a todos los ministros laicos que enriquecen el Cuerpo de Cristo. Que nuestra oración persistente produzca abundantes obreros, cada uno portador de la luz de Cristo para nuestro mundo.

REFLEXIÓN DE LAS ESCRITURAS



Jesús habla de orar por todo lo que necesitamos con fe y confianza, pero termina preguntando: “¿cuánto más el Padre celestial dará el Espíritu Santo a quienes se lo pidan?” (Lucas 1,13). ¿Está diciendo que hay límites a lo que podemos pedir? “Ten cuidado con lo que pides”, advierte el dicho. El hecho de que queramos algo no significa que será bueno para nosotros. Pero si tenemos suficiente fe para orar por algo, probablemente no oraríamos por nada malo. Entonces, ¿qué está diciendo realmente Jesús? Nos está dando dos lecciones sobre la oración. Primero, nos asegura que Dios escucha nuestras oraciones y las responde. Muchas personas toman el “pidan y se les dará” tan literalmente que esperan que Dios cumpla sus órdenes sin importar lo que quieran. Pero Dios es libre de hacer lo que es mejor para nosotros, libre de responder algunas oraciones con un no cuando lo que buscamos va en contra de la voluntad de Dios. Entonces, tal vez nuestra primera oración debería ser pedirle a Dios que nos muestre lo que realmente necesitamos. Esto nos lleva a la segunda lección: la oración nos cambia a nosotros, no a Dios. Si oráramos verdaderamente cómo oró Jesús, diríamos: “No según mi voluntad sino la tuya” (Mateo 26,39). No es fácil cambiar de opinión sobre lo que queremos o necesitamos. Cambiar nuestros deseos de egoístas a santos requiere mucho poder, el poder del Espíritu Santo. Jesús fue resucitado de entre los muertos por ese poder y nosotros también lo seremos (Romanos 8,11). Así que cuando Jesús promete que el Padre nos dará el Espíritu si se lo pedimos, el Espíritu es tanto la fuente como la respuesta a nuestras oraciones. Pidámosle al Espíritu que nos dé fuerzas para desear y orar por lo que realmente necesitamos. -Tom Schmidt
