





## MESSAGE FROM ARCHBISHOP GUSTAVO



Pope Leo XIV has said, “a bishop is a witness to hope by his example of a life firmly grounded in God and completely devoted to the service of the Church. This will be the case only insofar as he is conformed to Christ in his personal life and in his apostolic ministry.” These words are particularly true about Bishop Michael Boulette. With deep gratitude we honor him, as he enters retirement,

following 49 years, five months, and 21 days of priestly ministry, and eight years, five months, and 20 days of faithful episcopal service to the Church in San Antonio. From the earliest days of his priesthood – and even before, as a seminarian – Bishop Mike has given himself with zeal to the service of God’s people. As vicar general, his vision and leadership have been instrumental in the development of the Pastoral Ministry Center, which continues to lead ministers and strengthen the life of our local Church. In both liturgical and pastoral ministry, his wisdom and guidance have enriched the way we celebrate, pray, live and grow as a community of faith. The Church recently witnessed, in Pope Benedict XVI, the example of a shepherd who embraced retirement with wisdom and prudence. Those same virtues shine in Bishop Mike, who for some time has awaited this moment with hope and serenity. The Holy Father’s acceptance of his request is not an ending, but a new stage of service – through prayer, counsel, and faithful witness. On behalf of the entire Archdiocese, I offer heartfelt thanks for his dedication, compassion, and fidelity. Bishop Mike, thank you for walking with us, for teaching us, and for loving the Church so generously. May Our Lady of Guadalupe guide and protect you always.

## MEDITATION ON THE SCRIPTURES



The parable in today’s Gospel has a crooked steward who is commended by his master for being prudent, or clever, trying to protect himself. Jesus wanted us to be just as clever in serving the Lord. Let’s look at the first two

readings and how they challenge us to do more. The reading from Amos talks about those “who trample upon the needy and destroy the poor” (Amos 8:4). The challenge here is to ask yourself, “What do I do for the poor?” Most parishes have organizations to help the needy and are happy to get volunteers. Do you ever think of praying for the poor? Speaking of prayer, our second reading also challenges us to do more. Paul recommends prayers for “kings and for all in authority” (1 Timothy 2:2). It’s easy to pray for friends and family; how much time do we give to prayers for government leaders and executives? Paul reminds us that God wants everyone to be saved (1 Timothy 2:4), sinners as well as saints, terrorists and embezzlers, atheists and agnostics. I’ll bet you don’t spend much time praying for the “bad guys.” Yet Jesus said, “Love your enemies. Pray for those who hurt you” (Matthew 5:44). I can’t say I’ve ever heard anyone say that was their favorite Bible passage. But if Jesus expects more from those who love him, who are we to let him down? -Tom Schmidt

## NEW MINISTRY—RESPECT LIFE





## SECCIÓN EN ESPAÑOL

### REFLEXIÓN DE LAS ESCRITURAS



La parábola del Evangelio de hoy trata sobre un administrador deshonesto que es elogiado por su amo por ser hábil o astuto al intentar protegerse. Jesús quiere que seamos igual de astutos al servir al Señor. Analicemos las dos primeras lecturas y cómo nos desafían a hacer más. La lectura de Amós habla de quienes "los que buscan al pobre sólo para arruinarlo" (Amós 8,4). El desafío aquí es preguntarse: "¿Qué hago yo por los pobres?". La mayoría de las parroquias tienen organizaciones para ayudar a los necesitados y están felices de recibir voluntarios. ¿Alguna vez piensas en rezar por los pobres? Hablando de la oración, la segunda lectura también nos desafía a hacer más. Pablo recomienda orar por "por los jefes de Estado y las demás autoridades" (1 Timoteo 2,2). Es fácil rezar por amigos y familiares; ¿cuánto tiempo dedicamos a rezar por los líderes y ejecutivos del gobierno? Pablo nos recuerda que Dios quiere la salvación de todos (1 Timoteo 2,4), tanto pecadores como santos, terroristas y malversadores, ateos y agnósticos. Supongo que la mayoría de nosotros no dedicamos mucho tiempo a rezar por los "malos". Sin embargo, Jesús dijo: "Amen a sus enemigos. Oren por quienes los lastiman" (Mateo 5,44). No creo que haya escuchado a nadie decir que ese era su pasaje bíblico favorito, pero si Jesús espera más de quienes lo aman, ¿quiénes somos nosotros para defraudarlo?




