



MESSAGE FROM ARCHBISHOP GUSTAVO



Christ Himself calls us to solidarity with the poor, with the vulnerable, and with all creation, which suffers under the weight of exploitation and neglect. The “world” includes not only humanity but the whole of creation, which groans for redemption. If we wish to walk in its light, our discipleship must be expressed in daily habits that care for both our neighbor and our common home. We are invited to live simply, resisting the culture of waste. Before buying, we might ask: “Do I truly need this?” We can honor the Creator by reducing waste, recycling, reusing, and giving thanks for the gifts of food and water. In caring for water, conserving energy, planting a small garden, and avoiding the unnecessary use of resources, we embody the humility of Christ who emptied himself for us. From the cross springs forth resurrection, life, justice, and reconciliation. So let us take up our cross daily, not only by bearing life’s burdens with faith, but also by choosing small, faithful actions that heal the earth and serve the poor. In this way, we join Christ in sowing seeds of peace and hope until creation itself is renewed.



BIENVENIDOS A LA VIDA PARROQUIAL DE SAN GREGORIO MAGNO

SECCIÓN EN ESPAÑOL

MENSAJE DEL ARZOBISPO GUSTAVO



Cristo mismo nos llama a la solidaridad con los pobres, con los vulnerables y con toda la creación, que sufre bajo el peso de la explotación y el abandono. El "mundo" incluye no solo a la humanidad, sino a toda la creación, que gime por la redención. Si deseamos caminar a su luz, nuestro discipulado debe expresarse en hábitos diarios que cuiden tanto a nuestro prójimo como a nuestra casa común. Se nos invita a vivir con sencillez, resistiendo a la cultura del descarte. Antes de comprar, podríamos preguntarnos: "¿Realmente necesito esto?" Podemos honrar al Creador reduciendo el desperdicio, reciclando, reutilizando y dando gracias por los regalos de la comida y el agua. Al cuidar el agua, conservar la energía, plantar un pequeño jardín y evitar el uso innecesario de recursos, encarnamos la humildad de Cristo que se despojó de sí mismo por nosotros. De la cruz brota la resurrección, la vida, la justicia y la reconciliación. Así que tomemos nuestra cruz diariamente, no solo llevando las cargas de la vida con fe, sino también eligiendo acciones pequeñas y fieles que sanen la tierra y sirvan a los pobres. De esta manera, nos unimos a Cristo para sembrar semillas de paz y esperanza hasta que la creación misma se renueve.

REFLEXIÓN DE LAS ESCRITURAS



La lectura de hoy de la primera carta a Timoteo suena casi como la de un entrenador preparando a su equipo para un gran partido. Este entrenador tiene metas mucho más altas que un home run o un touchdown. En lugar de buscar un campeonato de liga, busca la fe, el amor, la paciencia y la amabilidad. ¿Y nosotros? ¿Estamos en el partido o sentado en el banquillo? Veamos a qué se refiere el entrenador Pablo. La fe es una relación con el Señor en la que imitamos la perspectiva de Jesús sobre la vida, sus enseñanzas, y su amor por Dios. Batallamos con sus mandatos de amar a los enemigos, poner la otra mejilla, perdonar todas las ofensas y tomar la cruz cada día. Como diría Pablo, estamos "luchando en el noble combate de la fe". Buscamos el amor escuchando el Evangelio, en el que Jesús cuenta la parábola del hombre rico que solo se preocupaba por su propia comodidad. Jesús dice que si realmente entendiéramos a los profetas, como en la primera lectura de Amós, no gastaríamos toda nuestra energía y riqueza en nosotros mismos. A medida que aprendemos a dejar atrás la necesidad de que todo salga como nosotros queremos, nos volvemos más pacientes con quienes no están de acuerdo con nosotros, o con las frustraciones y los problemas. Aprendemos a ver a Dios tanto en los fracasos como en los éxitos. Experimentar al Señor es el campeonato que anhelamos. Tom Schmidt
