

## CLERGY MEDITATION BY DCN. JOHN TREVINO



### How Well do We Suffer?

“Such is my gospel, for which I am suffering, even to the point of chains, like a criminal. But the word of God is not chained.”

How well do we suffer? That may be a confusing question, but it is an important one – because we are going to suffer in our lives.

Today, St. Paul reminds us that no matter how “chained” we are to our suffering “the word of God is not chained.” And just as important, our suffering can be used for the sake of others “so that they too may obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus.” So, how can this be? How can our suffering obtain salvation?

First, we must deal with how well we suffer. Often, when we share with someone what we are dealing with in our lives, we are told – “Offer it up!” or “Let go and let God!” As I was journeying into my faith, and I would have lots of questions and concerns, my lovely wife would tell me just that – “LET GO AND LET GOD!” I would be frustrated to no end because I did not know what it meant! Until I discovered the roadblock was – ME. It requires humility, obedience, and a loss of pride. As humans we tend to think we don’t need anyone’s help – no one understands what we are going through – no one can help us – certainly not God. We believe He does not have time for me and my issues. Not true! All false – false statements and false pride. God has every moment for us “if we persevere – we shall also reign with him.” God always has the time, patience, help, and love for us. We are so beautifully told this today: “If we deny him – he will deny us. If we are unfaithful – he remains faithful, for he cannot deny himself.”

As for salvation of souls? When we “offer up” our suffering to Jesus as “redemptive suffering” for our own salvation or for that of others, as Catholics, we believe it takes on a redemptive power. Jesus died for us, and He invites us to join our suffering to His Passion. It allows us to love others as He loves – it allows to be more like Christ. Most importantly, it allows Him to walk with us through our own suffering. But do not just stop there! Offer everything to Jesus – our joys and our sorrows, our happiness and our thanksgivings, our gratitude, and our hopes. Offer it all to Christ – because what He really wants – is YOU!

Let go and let God – offer it up!

## MEDITACIÓN DEL CLERO POR DCN. JOHN TREVINO



¿Qué tan bien sufrimos?

"Tal es mi evangelio, por el cual estoy sufriendo, hasta el punto de las cadenas, como un criminal. Pero la palabra de Dios no está encadenada".

¿Qué tan bien sufrimos? Esa puede ser una pregunta confusa, pero es importante, porque vamos a sufrir en nuestras vidas.

Hoy, San Pablo nos recuerda que no importa cuán "encadenados" estemos a nuestro sufrimiento, "la palabra de Dios no está encadenada". Y lo que es igual de importante, nuestro sufrimiento puede ser usado por el bien de los demás "para que ellos también obtengan la salvación que es en Cristo Jesús". Entonces, ¿cómo puede ser esto? ¿Cómo puede nuestro sufrimiento obtener la salvación?

Primero, debemos lidiar con lo bien que sufrimos. Muchas veces, cuando compartimos con alguien con lo que estamos encontrando en nuestras vidas, se nos dice: "¡Ofrécelo!" o "¡Déjalo ir y deja a Dios!" Mientras viajaba hacia mi fe, y tenía muchas preguntas e inquietudes, mi encantadora esposa me decía precisamente eso: "¡DÉJALO IR Y DEJA A DIOS!" ¡Me sentiría frustrado sin fin porque no sabía lo que significaba! Hasta que descubrí que el obstáculo era yo. Requiere humildad, obediencia y pérdida de orgullo. Como humanos, tendemos a pensar que no necesitamos la ayuda de nadie, nadie entiende por lo que estamos pasando, nadie puede ayudarnos, ciertamente no Dios. Creemos que Él no tiene tiempo para mí y mis problemas. ¡No es verdad! Todo falso: declaraciones falsas y falso orgullo. Dios tiene cada momento para nosotros "si perseveramos, también reinaremos con él". Dios siempre tiene el tiempo, la paciencia, la ayuda y el amor para nosotros. Hoy se nos dice tan bellamente esto: "Si lo negamos, él nos negará. Si somos infieles, él permanece fiel, porque no puede negarse a sí mismo".

¿En cuanto a la salvación de las almas? Cuando "ofrecemos" nuestro sufrimiento a Jesús como "sufrimiento redentor" por nuestra propia salvación o por la de los demás, como católicos, creemos que adquiere un poder redentor. Jesús murió por nosotros y nos invita a unir nuestro sufrimiento a su Pasión. Nos permite amar a los demás como Él ama, nos permite ser más como Cristo. Lo más importante es que le permite caminar con nosotros a través de nuestro propio sufrimiento. ¡Pero no te quedes ahí! Ofrécele todo a Jesús: nuestras alegrías y nuestras tristezas, nuestra felicidad y nuestras acciones de gracias, nuestra gratitud y nuestras esperanzas. ¡Ofrécele todo a Cristo, porque lo que Él realmente quiere, eres TÚ!



**UNDERSTANDING HEALING by Fr. Richard:** Why does God allow suffering? It is a valid question. I will try to answer. God would not allow evil in his creation unless he intended to bring good out of it (see St. Thomas Aquinas, Summa Theologia, Part I, q.2, a.3). God is not the cause of evil and suffering. He allows it because He brings about a greater good through it. Jesus' death on the cross is the greatest example. The world is redeemed through his suffering and death. Jesus makes human suffering a part of the work of redemption. Since we are members of the body of Christ, our suffering can be joined with his suffering. It can be a form of union with God, the Father. This unification may bring about the healing we seek or God

may allow the suffering to continue so that a greater good may be achieved. 2 Corinthians 12:9-10 – "...but he said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for power is made perfect in weakness.' I will rather boast most gladly of my weaknesses, in order that the power of Christ may dwell in me. Therefore, I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and constraints, for the sake of Christ; for when I am weak, then I am strong."

In addition, it is important that when you pray, Pray in faith that God will heal you or the person you pray for. When you pray for healing, be bold in your asking. Believe God for the healing in the person's life. **God's name and nature reveal that He is a God who is willing and able to heal.** This is a powerful motivation for praying for healing. Don't be intimidated or afraid to pray for healing. It is in God's hands. **He is the One who heals.** Your responsibility is to pray to Him for the release of His healing power. Cry out to Him in faith for healing in the life of the person. Be submissive to the Holy Spirit's leadership when praying for healing. As you pray in faith for healing, be sensitive to the Spirit's leadership. He can and will grant you insights that you will need to intercede for this person or for you. He can reveal areas that you need to cover in your praying for the sick person or maybe you. Ask Him to make you sensitive to His leadership as you pray for healing.
