

MORNING MASS AND LITURGY OF THE HOURS



The **Liturgy of the Hours** is an ancient tradition of the Church that observes specific times of prayer throughout the day using Psalms, Gospel passages, intercessory prayers, and antiphons. The prayers vary according to the date, time of prayer, liturgical season, and saint

of the day. The sequence of prayers in the Liturgy of the Hours is rooted in the Psalms and comes from the monastic practice of praying through all of the Psalms as often as possible. The Liturgy of the Hours provides a way for us to pray without ceasing (see 1 Thessalonians 5:16) and offers a rhythm for the spiritual life.

GOD'S DIVINE PROMISE

We live in a tough world. Some people have to face hardship when growing up. Imagine being born into a family without a mother or father or totally without parents. Imagine a broken family. The child may find no provision for regular or proper meals. There may be a lack of emotional and physical care. Whoever is caring for the child may be struggling with work to upkeep the family. Then the child grows up and goes to school into a world of strangers. This is a difficult environment which the child finds difficult to cope with. The child develops insecurity and is anxious about what is going to come next. It becomes difficult to cope in school as the home environment is unstable. The mental and emotional foundation becomes weakened. When growing up as a youth and progressing into adult life, if the environment is not cooperative, this person will likely struggle mentally and emotionally. Reach out to a mighty God, the creator of the universe. No matter what situation you may find yourself in, this mighty God is there for you. I am sharing with you this vital knowledge so you can turn to this source of strength. He has a divine promise of assistance. Go to Joshua 1: 5-11 read it and make this God's command for you. God is for you and will be there for you. Stay strong and not be discouraged. Know that you will succeed when you follow his ways.

Joshua 1:5-11 -No one can withstand you as long as you live. As I was with Moses, I will be with you: I will not leave you nor forsake you. Be strong and steadfast, so that you may give this people possession of the land I swore to their ancestors that I would give them. Only be strong and steadfast, being careful to observe the entire law which Moses my servant enjoined on you. Do not swerve from it either to the right or to the left, that you may succeed wherever you go. Do not let this book of the law depart from your lips. Recite it by day and by night, that you may carefully observe all that is written in it; then you will attain your goal; then you will succeed. I command you: be strong and steadfast! Do not fear nor be dismayed, for the LORD, your God, is with you wherever you go. So Joshua commanded the officers of the people: "Go through the camp and command the people, 'Prepare your provisions, for three days from now you shall cross the Jordan here, to march in and possess the land the LORD, your God, is giving as your possession.'"

EDUCATION SAVINGS ACCOUNT

AT A GLANCE

SCHOOL



WHAT IS AN EDUCATION SAVINGS ACCOUNT?

An Education Savings Account (ESA) is a new state program that gives families access to funds (~\$10,000 per child) to use for approved educational expenses, including Catholic school tuition, uniforms, technology, tutoring and more.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Any student who is eligible to enroll in a Texas public school may apply. This includes students currently in public, private, or homeschool settings, as well as those entering kindergarten. ESAs will be distributed through a lottery system, so every eligible family is encouraged to submit an application.

WHEN DOES THE PROGRAM START?

Applications open in January 2026, with funds available for the 2026–2027 school year.

HOW DO ESA'S HELP CATHOLIC SCHOOL FAMILIES?

For many families, tuition cost has been the biggest barrier to Catholic education. With ESAs, the doors to Catholic schools are more open than ever—making an excellent, faith-filled education possible for more children.

CAN CURRENT CATHOLIC SCHOOL FAMILIES APPLY?

Yes. If your child is eligible to enroll in a Texas public school, you may apply for an ESA—even if your child is already attending a Catholic school.

DO I STILL NEED TO APPLY FOR TUITION ASSISTANCE (HOPE FOR THE FUTURE)?

Recognizing that not all families will receive an ESA award for the upcoming 2026–2027 school year, tuition assistance will continue to be awarded to families who meet eligibility requirements for Hope for the Future (HFF). We know that Hope for the Future does not cover the full amount of tuition, but it is still an integral part of keeping our Catholic schools affordable for more families. HFF Application and Award information will be released this Fall, and all families are eligible to apply, though funds will be reserved for families who do not receive ESA funding.

WHERE CAN I GET HELP WITH THE APPLICATION?

The Department of Catholic Schools- Archdiocese of San Antonio will provide ESA information sessions, step-by-step guides, and application workshops to help families through the process. Make sure to fill out the QR Code at the bottom to stay connected.

WHAT ARE THE "PRIORITY GROUPS" FOR FUNDING?

While every eligible family is encouraged to apply, the state has designated priority groups for funding distribution. Here is the breakdown of each funding group:

- TIER 1:** Students with a **disability** (defined by Texas Education Code Sec. 29.003) whose family income is **= or <500%** of the Federal Poverty Guidelines (FPG)
- TIER 2:** Children whose family income is **= or <200%** of FPG
- TIER 3:** Children whose family income is between **200% and 500%** of FPG
- TIER 4: Everyone else** (depends on available funds). Students who wish to transfer from public schools will be prioritized over currently enrolled private school students in this category only.
