

PRAYING THROUGH ANXIETY

Let's face it. Almost everyone who is anxious and prays to God is probably praying for God to solve whatever problems are making them anxious, or for God to remove their anxious feelings. Whether it's emotional upset over a medical diagnosis, a ruptured relationship, financial woes, a failed job, or the latest political uproar, most of us want God to either remove the problem or the anxiety. But sometimes, even when we pray, neither seems to happen. So, what are we to do?

One piece of helpful advice, "When we are hurting or obsessed, the problem is that we are able to think about only one thing, the object of our hurt or loss." Thus, in times of anxiety, we end up "oppressively focusing" on the cause of our upset. And that can make us even more anxious!

The key is to turn our focus from ourselves to God. For me, this means first being honest with God about the problem. Then I turn the problem over to God. Sometimes I imagine this physically, as if I were handing over a package: "This is yours now, God." Next, I focus on a Gospel story in which I can imagine myself in Jesus' company, focusing on him rather than me. This method helps me a great deal. It takes me away from myself and reminds me that there is more to life than my problem, and that in Jesus' company, I can relax. Ironically, then, praying through anxiety often means, after handing things over to God, not praying with your anxiety, or at the very least, not focusing on it.

MEDITACION POR EL DIACONO FRED CAMPOS



Orar a través de la ansiedad Seamos realistas. Casi todos los que están ansiosos y oran a Dios probablemente están orando para que Dios resuelva cualquier problema que los esté inquietando, o para que Dios elimine sus sentimientos ansiosos. Ya sea que se trate de un malestar emocional por un diagnóstico médico, una relación rota, problemas financieros, un trabajo fallido o el último alboroto político, la mayoría de nosotros queremos que Dios elimine el problema o la ansiedad. Pero a veces, incluso cuando oramos, parece que ninguna de las dos cosas sucede. Entonces, ¿qué debemos hacer? Un consejo útil: "Cuando estamos heridos u obsesionados, el problema es que podemos pensar en una sola cosa, el objeto de nuestro dolor o pérdida". Por lo tanto, en tiempos de ansiedad, terminamos "enfocándonos opresivamente" en la causa de nuestro malestar. ¡Y eso puede ponernos aún más ansiosos! La clave es cambiar nuestro enfoque de nosotros mismos a Dios. Para mí, esto significa primero ser honesto con Dios sobre el problema. Luego le entrego el problema a Dios. "Esto es tuyo ahora, Dios". A continuación, me concentro en una historia del Evangelio en la que puedo imaginarme en compañía de Jesús, centrándome en él en lugar de en mí. Este método me ayuda mucho. Me aleja de mí mismo y me recuerda que hay más en la vida que mi problema, y que en compañía de Jesús, puedo relajarme. Irónicamente, entonces, orar a través de la ansiedad a menudo significa, después de entregar las cosas a Dios, no orar con su ansiedad, o al menos, no concentrarse en ella.


