

HAPPY AND BLESSED MARRIAGE BY FR. RICHARD SAMOUR



Even that I am not a married person, my 13 years as a priest and a mature life has helped me to understand better the difficulties, challenges and blessings in a marriage. I want to share with you some suggestions that couples can consider.

- 1. Express your love every day:** To build a strong, love-charged marriage, you have to make it a priority to show and express that love every single day. This is a lot easier for some people (and some couples) who find saying "I love you" or showing physical affection to be very natural. But this is not all couples, and it is certainly not all individuals. Make an effort to express daily your love. When was the last time you wrote a letter to your spouse?
- 2. Be in charge of your own emotions:** Having a spouse around to support you and help you with your problems is wonderful (especially when getting through hard times together), but it can be easy to fall into a trap of wanting them to fix things for you.
- 3. Keep divorce off the table:** In marriage, the "D" word can be a scary threat. It could be worth setting a rule together that you'll keep that word off the table. A sacramental marriage is between three people: husband, wife and God.
- 4. Always maintain a team mindset:** When you know you are a team, it makes it easier to remember that you're not working against each other, even when you're in conflict. If you're thinking and working like a team, you'll stay a team—and a winning team at that. Keep no secrets.
- 5. Show gratitude and appreciation for your spouse:** Gratitude and appreciation are also extremely valuable. You don't need to make a grand gesture to show your partner that you appreciate them. It can be easier than you think to do this. A simple "thank you" or a quick compliment can go a long way.
- 6. Strive to give more than you get:** We humans love to be selfish. Creating an amazing relationship is the act of working on ourselves. Think that any action is for the common good of the family. Marriage is not about 50%-50% it is 100%-100% . **Do not let ego win.**
- 7. Keep intimacy alive:** Closeness is an incredibly important part of any marriage. This closeness, or intimacy, is physical, emotional, and even spiritual. This is one of the differences between sacramental marriage and civilly marriage: during intimacy, God is present and blessed the relationship.
- 8. And the most important: God and the Church at the center of your marriage.** Without God's blessings nothing will work. Never stop learning about what love is. Civil union is not a sacrament nor does God abide in the relationship. The Church always open its arms for all children who are looking for the sacrament of marriage. Let us talk. I can help.




HELP US TO CARE ABOUT GOD'S CREATION

LA BENDICIÓN DEL MATRIMONIO POR P. RICHARD



Aunque no soy una persona casada, mis 13 años como sacerdote y mi experiencia de vida me han ayudado a comprender mejor las dificultades, los desafíos y las bendiciones en un matrimonio. Quiero compartir con ustedes algunas sugerencias

que las parejas pueden considerar.

1. Expresa tu amor todos los días: Para construir un matrimonio fuerte y lleno de amor, debes tener como prioridad el mostrar y expresar ese amor todos los días. Esto es mucho más fácil para algunas personas que encuentran que decir "Te amo" o mostrar afecto físico es muy natural. Pero esto no es en todas las parejas, y ciertamente no son todos los individuos. Haz un esfuerzo por expresar tu amor diariamente. ¿Cuándo fue la última vez que le escribiste una carta a tu cónyuge?

2. Se Responsable de tus emociones: Tener un cónyuge cerca para apoyarlo y ayudarlo con sus problemas es maravilloso (especialmente cuando atraviesan momentos difíciles juntos), pero puede ser fácil caer en la trampa de querer que alguien arregle las cosas por usted.

3. Mantenga el divorcio fuera de la mesa: En el matrimonio, la palabra "D" puede ser una amenaza aterradora. Podría valer la pena establecer una regla juntos de que mantendrás esa palabra fuera de la mesa. **Un matrimonio sacramental es entre tres personas: esposo, esposa y Dios.**

4. Mantenga siempre una mentalidad de equipo: Cuando sabe que es un equipo, es más fácil recordar que no están trabajando unos contra otros, incluso cuando están en conflicto. Si piensas y trabajas como en equipo, seguirás siendo un equipo, y un equipo ganador. No guardes secretos.

5. Muestre gratitud y aprecio por su cónyuge: La gratitud y el aprecio también son extremadamente valiosos. No es necesario que hagas un gran gesto para demostrarle a tu pareja que la aprecias. Puede ser más fácil de lo que piensas hacer esto. Un simple "gracias" o un cumplido rápido pueden ser de gran ayuda.

6. Esfuérzate por dar más de lo que recibes: A los humanos nos encanta ser egoístas. Crear una relación increíble es el acto de trabajar en nosotros mismos. Piensa que cualquier acción es por el bien común de la familia. El matrimonio no se trata de 50%-50%, es 100%-100%. **No dejes que el ego gane.**

7. Mantenga viva la intimidad: La cercanía es una parte increíblemente importante de cualquier matrimonio. Esta cercanía, o intimidad, es física, emocional e incluso espiritual. Esta es una de las diferencias entre el matrimonio sacramental y el matrimonio civil: durante la intimidad, Dios está presente y bendice la relación.

8. Y lo más importante: Dios y la Iglesia en el centro de tu matrimonio. Sin las bendiciones de Dios, nada funcionará. Nunca dejes de aprender sobre lo que es el amor. La unión civil no es un sacramento ni Dios permanece en la relación. La Iglesia siempre abre sus brazos para todos aquellos que buscan el sacramento del matrimonio. Hablemos. Te Puedo ayudar.
