

THE WONDERS OF GOD

Have you noticed the people of our time have removed the wonders of God from their lives? They have lost the awe found in the presence of God. This is because the focus is on the things made by man. Preoccupied by what man can do. Detached from God and what God has done and can do. Refuse to believe in the wonders God has done.



God from the very beginning of time wants man to turn to him and talk about him so as to remember him and believe in him. But what do we do? We steer away from him engaging in our own pursuits. This is the reason why it is becoming ever more difficult to believe in him. Some people I know even say that believing in God found in the Bible is nothing but fairy tale. Yes, even those who are said to be Christians and Catholics are becoming this way.

Do you know the story of St. Gregory the Great withholding Holy Communion from a woman who made the hosts for mass? She doubted and laughed that the hosts she made could be the Body and Blood of Christ by the words of consecration. St. Gregory prayed that God would enlighten her. After praying St. Gregory noticed some consecrated hosts changed into actual flesh and blood. He showed these to the woman who was moved and repented for her unbelief. She then knelt and wept in reverence and sorrow. St. Gregory then gave her the host.

These miraculous Hosts can still be venerated at Andechs Abbey in Germany. They are celebrated at the Feast of the Three Hosts of Andechs.

God is real and there is life after death, are these too good to be true? Believe these supernatural truths and allow God more intimately into your lives and see the wonders that come with it.

¿QUIÉN PUEDE APLICAR? Cualquier estudiante que sea elegible para inscribirse en una escuela pública de Texas puede aplicar. Esto incluye a estudiantes que actualmente están en escuelas públicas, privadas o en educación en casa, así como quienes entran a kínder. Las ESAs se asignarán por medio de un sorteo, por lo que toda familia elegible está invitada a presentar una solicitud.


