



### CLERGY MEDITATION BY DCN. BERNARD CHAN



There is a story of a mighty king who loves a humble maiden. People trembled before his power. No one dares speak against him, for he has the strength to crush anyone opposing him. Yet, this powerful king was softened by love for a humble maiden.

He was in a dilemma, as to how he could make his love known to her. If he brought her to his kingdom and made her queen with jewels and royal clothes she certainly would not resist for no one dares to resist his power. He would not know if she would truly love him.

She may say she loves him, but would it be genuine? Would she then live with him in fear, and regret the old life she left behind? Would she be happy as his queen? How could he tell?

If he approached her in her humble home with his entourage that may overwhelm her too. He does not want her to cringe and give in to his kingship. He wants a lover, even an equal. He wants her not to see him as a king and even herself as a humble maiden. He wants to let shared love cross over the separation between them.

It is only through love that the unequal can be made equal. The king realizes he could not elevate the maiden without overwhelming her freedom, so he decided to descend to her level. He clothed himself as a poor beggar and approached her home concealing his identity, with worn clothing fitting loosely about him. He was not merely disguised, but he took on a new identity. He renounced his throne to win her heart.

God, like the king in this story takes on a new form: He becomes man, a most shocking descent imaginable to win our hearts. Are we able to see past his humble act and accept a profound relationship with him and leave our old lives behind?



### REFLEXIÓN POR EL DIACONO BERNARD



La historia de un rey poderoso que ama a una humilde doncella. La gente temblaba ante su poder. Nadie se atreve a hablar en su contra, porque tiene la fuerza para aplastar a cualquiera que se le oponga. Sin embargo, este poderoso rey se ablandó por el amor a una humilde doncella. Él se encontraba en un dilema sobre cómo podía hacerle saber su amor. Si la llevara a su reino y la hiciera reina con joyas y ropas reales, desde luego no se resistiría, porque nadie se atreve a resistirse a su poder. No sabría si ella realmente le amaría. Puede que diga que le quiere, pero ¿sería sincero? ¿Viviría entonces con él con miedo y lamentaría la vida anterior que dejó atrás? ¿Sería feliz como su reina? ¿Cómo iba a saberlo? Si se le acercaba en su humilde hogar con su séquito, eso también la abrumaría a ella. No quiere que ella se estremezca y ceda a su reinado. Quiere un amante, incluso un igual. Quiere que ella no le vea como un rey ni siquiera a ella como una humilde doncella. Quiere dejar que el amor compartido cruce la separación entre ellos. Solo a través del amor de desiguales pueden igualarse. El rey se da cuenta de que no podía elevar a la doncella sin abrumar su libertad, así que decide descender a su nivel. Se vistió como un pobre mendigo y se acercó a su casa ocultando su identidad, con ropa gastada que le quedaba holgada. No solo estaba disfrazado, sino que adoptó una nueva identidad. Renunció a su trono para ganarse su corazón. Dios, como el rey de esta historia, toma una nueva forma: se convierte en hombre, una caída sorprendente que se puede imaginar para conquistar nuestros corazones. ¿Seremos capaces de ver más allá de su humilde acto, aceptar una relación profunda con él y dejar atrás nuestras vidas anteriores?

### MEDITANDO LAS ESCRITURAS

A menudo nos envolvemos tanto en todas las preparaciones para la Navidad que nos olvidamos por completo del Adviento. Las lecturas nos recuerdan que, a pesar del estrés que podamos sentir al pensar en lo cerca que está la Navidad, estamos llamados a regocijarnos porque el Señor está cerca. El estrés que sentimos puede deberse al miedo. Pero, ¿alguna vez has notado que es mucho más fácil cuando tienes a alguien que te acompaña en las compras, o te ayude a escribir las tarjetas navideñas o a decorar el árbol? “[D]a gritos de júbilo... No temas”, dice el profeta Sofonías en la primera lectura (Sofonías 3,14). No dice que el Señor viene a castigarnos por esperar hasta el último minuto para poner el árbol. El profeta dice que el Señor está en medio de nosotros, no estamos solos. “[H]a expulsado a todos tus enemigos” (Sofonías 3,15). Y como si eso no fuera suficiente, dice que el Señor se goza y se complace en nosotros. ¿Cuántas veces te has preguntado si podrías pedirle ayuda al Señor? Sofonías nos recuerda que le da gusto al Señor ayudarnos. Y san Pablo dice lo mismo en la segunda lectura: “No se inquieten por nada; más bien presenten... sus peticiones a Dios” (Flp 4,6). Ahí es donde entra en juego el Adviento. Podemos anticipar la presencia del Señor en nuestras vidas. Por eso la fe y la esperanza son centrales al tema del Adviento. La fe en el amor que Dios tiene por nosotros nos da la esperanza de que nos apoya en la debilidad y nos llena con la mis

### **Pope Leo XIV and Youth**

Pope Leo XIV spoke to teenagers during a digital encounter at Lucas Oil Stadium on Friday in Indianapolis during the 2025 National Catholic Youth Conference (NCYC).

Five teenagers asked the pope questions regarding using technology, recovering from mistakes, giving worries to Jesus, avoiding distractions, and preparing for the future of the Church. The pope gave guidance to the young crowd with words applicable to both teenagers and the universal Church.

The Holy Father's advice that Catholics can apply to their lives included:

#### **Sin never has the final word**

"All of us struggle," Leo said. "The truth is that none of us is perfect."

"St. Paul teaches that everyone has sinned and fallen short of the glory of God ... Because of original sin, we sometimes do the opposite of what we know is right. But there's good news. Sin never has the final word," the pope said.

"Whenever we ask for God's mercy, he forgives us. Pope Francis said that God never gets tired of forgiving. We sometimes get tired of asking for forgiveness. So even when we fall again, we should remember St. Paul's words, 'Christ Jesus, came into the world to save sinners.' He came for us, knowing our weaknesses," he said.

"It can be discouraging when we fall, but do not focus on all your sins. Look to Jesus. Trust his mercy and go to him with confidence. He will always welcome you home," he said.

#### **Give your worries to God**

"In his first letter, St. Peter tells us to give all our worries to Jesus because he cares for us," Pope Leo said. "Jesus does not just understand our struggles from a distance. He actually wants us to hand them to him because he loves us."

"That trust starts when we have a real relationship. We cannot give our problems to someone whom we barely know. Think of your closest friends, for example. If they were hurting, you would talk to them. You would listen to them.

You would stay close. Our relationship with Jesus is similar," he said.

"He knows when life feels heavy. Scripture reminds us that he is near to the brokenhearted. Even when we do not feel his presence, our faith tells us that he is there. To entrust our struggles to Jesus, we have to spend time with him in prayer. We have to have a relationship with him," he said.

"Daily moments of silence are so important, whether through adoration, reading Scripture, talking to him, looking for those little spaces of time where we can be with him. Little by little, we learn to hear his voice, to feel his presence, both within and through the people that he sends to us," the pope said.

#### **Find real friends**

"It's ... important to pray for the gift of true friends," the pope said. "A real friend is not only someone who's fun to be with, oh, that is good, too. But it's someone who helps you grow closer to Jesus, someone who encourages you to become a better person. Good friends also push us to seek help when life gets difficult or confusing."

"Good friends will always tell us the truth, even when that's not easy to do. Scripture says that faithful friends are like a strong shelter and a treasure. I hope you are forming friendships like that, even during this conference. Friendships rooted in faith, rooted in love for Jesus," the pope said.

#### **It's OK to get distracted, but then come back to God**

When we get distracted in prayer, "sometimes the best thing to do is to follow the distraction for a moment, see why it's there," Pope Leo said. Then after acknowledging it, "turn back and remember why you're there and why you're in prayer and to say to the Lord, 'Look I'm distracted right now. I know you understand.'"

"But not to allow yourself to be taken too far away, especially during prayer, because there are all kinds of temptations and all kinds of distractions, but there's only one Jesus Christ, and we really need to give our time also in prayer to Christ," the pope said.

#### **Technology should serve your life, not the other way around**

"Technology can really help in many ways," and it "can help us live our Christian faith," Pope Leo said. "It lets us stay connected with people who are far away ... It also gives us amazing tools for prayer, for reading the Bible, for learning more about what we believe."

"It allows us to share the Gospel with people we may never meet in person. But even with all that, technology can never replace real in-person relationships. Simple things, a hug, a handshake, a smile. All those things are essential to being human," he said.

"Watching Mass online can be helpful, especially when someone is sick or elderly or cannot attend in person. But actually being there, taking part in the Eucharist, is so important for our prayer, for our sense of community," the pope said.

"It's essential for our relationship with God and with each other. There's nothing that can replace true human presence, being with one another. While technology certainly can connect us, it's not the same as being physically present."

#### **Jesus will always protect, guide, and love his Church**

"When we face challenges or worries about the future, it might be good to remember that promise that Jesus once made to Peter when he said, 'The gates of hell will not prevail against the Church.' Jesus will always protect, guide, and love his Church," the pope said.

"The day I was elected pope, I said, 'God loves us, and evil will not prevail,'" the pope said. "We are all in God's hands. Jesus wants everyone to come close to him."

"The Church prepares for the future by staying faithful to what Jesus asks of us today. He told us not to be overwhelmed by worries but to seek first the kingdom of God, trusting that everything else will fall into place. He promised that the Holy Spirit would guide us and help us understand what we need to do," the pope said.
