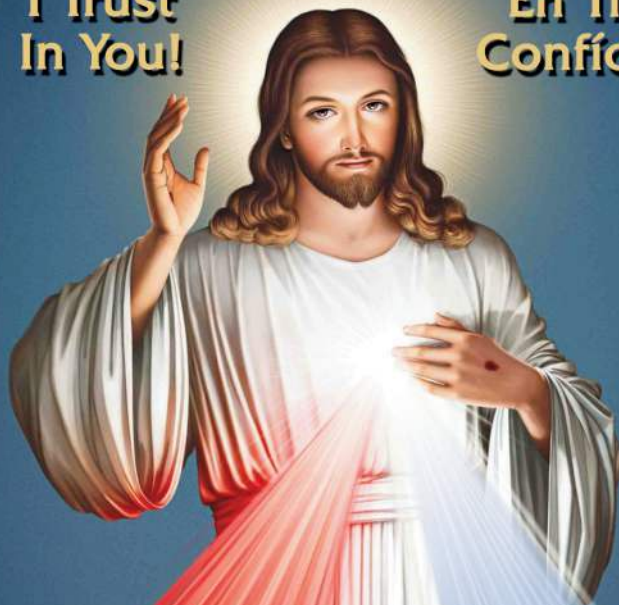

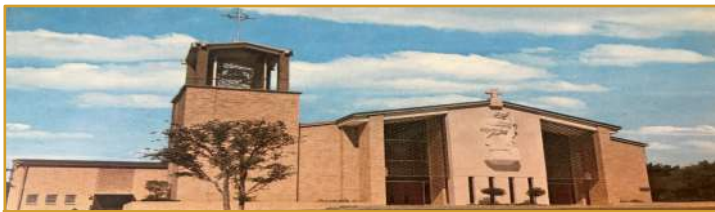

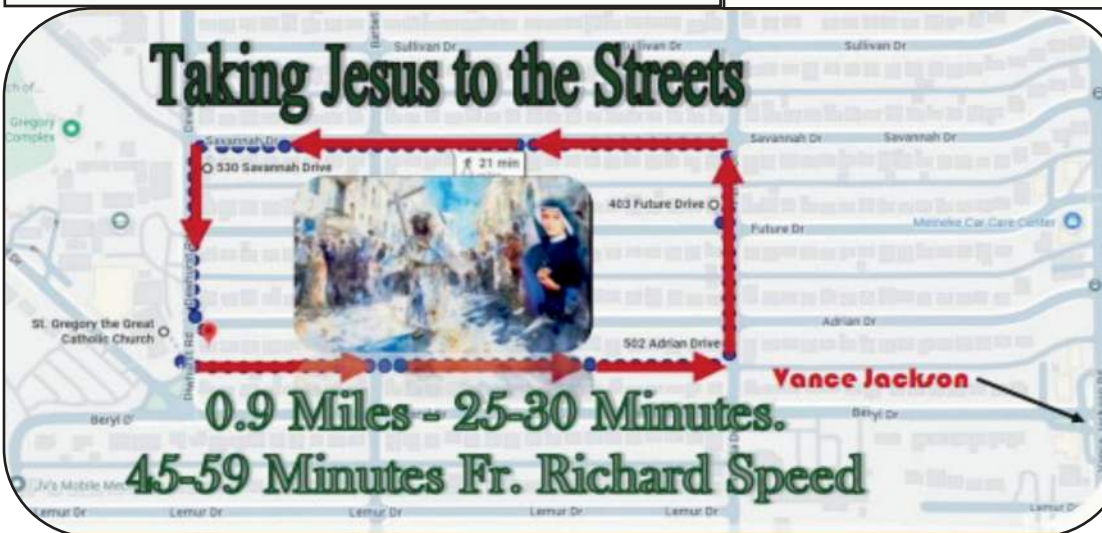

### INDULGENCIA PLENARIA EN LA FIESTA DE LA DIVINA MISERICORDIA

En la Fiesta de la Divina Misericordia se concede una indulgencia plenaria (el perdón de todas las penas temporales resultantes de pecados que ya se han confesado) si a todos los fieles que se confiesan, reciben la Sagrada Comunión, rezan por las intenciones del Santo Padre, y "en cualquier iglesia o capilla, con un espíritu completamente desprendido del afecto por un pecado, incluso un pecado venial, participan en las oraciones y devociones que se realizan en honor de la Divina Misericordia, o que, en presencia del Santísimo Sacramento expuesto o reservado en el tabernáculo, recitan el Padre Nuestro y el Credo, añadiendo una oración devota al Señor Jesús misericordioso (por ejemplo: '**Jesús misericordioso, en ti confío**!')".

Al final de cada misa habrá procesion dentro de la Iglesia con el Santísimo y bendición final.

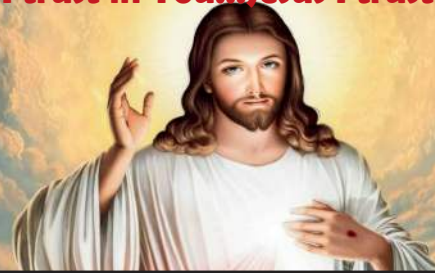

### INDULGENCES FOR DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

**REQUIREMENT: RECONCILIATION, ATTEND MASS AND RECEIVE COMMUNION.**

A plenary indulgence (the forgiveness of all temporal punishment resulting from sins that have already been confessed) is granted on the Feast of Divine Mercy if to all the faithful who go to Confession, receive Holy Communion, pray for the intentions of the Holy Father, and "in any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy, or who, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. '**Merciful Jesus, I trust in you!**')."

**On the weekend of Divine Mercy, at the end of each Mass, we will have a procession inside the Church and Benediction.. This is a good opportunity for you to receive indulgences or to offer for a loved one who have gone.**

### THE DIVINE MERCY MESSAGE AND DEVOTION

The message of The Divine Mercy is simple. It is that God loves us – all of us. And, He wants us to recognize that His mercy is greater than our sins, so that we will call upon Him with trust, receive His mercy, and let it flow through us to others. Thus, all will come to share His joy.

The Divine Mercy message is one we can call to mind simply by remembering ABC:

**A** - Ask for His Mercy. God wants us to approach Him in prayer constantly, repenting of our sins and asking Him to pour His mercy out upon us and upon the whole world.

**B** - Be merciful. God wants us to receive His mercy and let it flow through us to others. He wants us to extend love and forgiveness to others just as He does to us.

**C** - Completely trust in Jesus. God wants us to know that the graces of His mercy are dependent upon our trust. The more we trust in Jesus, the more we will receive.

## ARCHBISHOP GUSTAVO MEDITATION



We are a people marked by the anointing. The first missionaries came to this land three centuries ago. Among them was the Venerable Friar Antonio Margil de Jesús. He walked this very soil. And this year, we mark 300 years since his death. From those beginnings to the archdiocese, we are today, one thing has not changed: we have been anointed, generation after generation, for the same mission. One year ago, we gathered while Pope Francis lay gravely ill, nearing his final departure to the Father's house. His voice had grown faint, yet his witness blazed with the very chrism of gladness he had proclaimed for years. Now Pope Leo XIV walks among us, and his first words to the world were words of Easter: "Peace be with you... peace that is unarmed and disarming, humble and persevering." A peace that we eagerly anticipate. From suffering to resurrection, from one shepherd to another: this is precisely the rhythm of Holy Week, the rhythm sealed by oil into our very flesh and soul. Blessed Mother of Guadalupe – you who stood on this hemisphere before our institutions existed, who carried within you the Anointed One Himself – obtain for us the grace to remain fragrant, poured out, unafraid.

## DIVINE MERCY MESSAGE FROM FR RICHARD



God's mercy is a monumental theme in Scripture, in the English Bibles the word appears 341 times. However, in the Hebrew and Greek Bibles the word Mercy appear 454 and it is also translated as "kindness," "loving kindness," "goodness," "favor," "compassion," and "pity." The first time that appear in the Bible is in the Book of Genesis 19:19, "Your servant has found favor in your eyes, and you have shown great mercy to me in sparing my life."

We have heard in the Psalm: "Give thanks to the Lord for he is good, his love is everlasting. Let the house of Israel say, "His mercy endures forever."

This day we celebrate the richness, meaning, participation in and application of God's mercy for us. This day we cry out with St. Thomas: "My Lord and My God" (Jn 20:28). This is the day the Lord has made.

To understanding the meaning of mercy, it will help if we examine its etymology. Our English word, mercy, goes back to the Latin: misericordia, which is composed of two words. "Cordia" It means heart. The first part, "misery" refers to suffering. Mercy, then, means to have a heart for those who suffer or, more precisely, to have a heart willing to suffer for others.

The message giving to St Faustina was, "I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened."

Today's readings reveal that kind of heart in Christ and in his followers. When Jesus appeared to his disciples that first Easter, he said, "Peace be with you." As you can imagine, that greeting meant more than "hello" or "good morning." Jesus, in fact, desired to communicate to them something of huge value. The peace which Jesus won for us had cost him his blood, his very life. In addition to his peace, Jesus says: "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them..." To his apostles Jesus communicates the Holy Spirit with the power to free men from their sins. That freedom or absolution comes through the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Let us connect the Scriptures with Today feast : By Jesus' own words, the rays indicate the Blood and Water that poured from His heart when it was pierced on the Cross.

Jesus said that the Water is what makes souls righteous and the Blood is the life of souls. So we can see that the Water washes away our sins, just like in Baptism or Confession and that the Blood gives us life, just like in Holy Communion. Remember when Jesus said, "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you do not have life within you.

The beautiful prayer in the bottom in the image says, "Jesus I trust in You." As Mother Theresa summarized, "If we pray, we will believe; if we believe, we will love; if we love, we will serve. Only then we put our love of God into action."

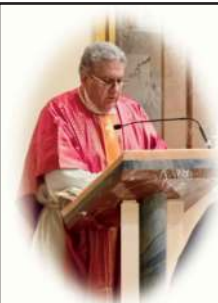

## MEDITACION DEL DOMINGO DE LA MISERICORDIA POR P. RICHARD

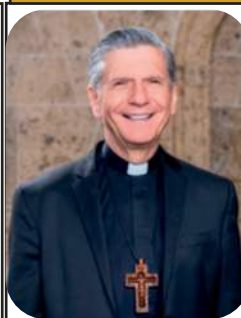


La misericordia de Dios es un tema monumental en las Escrituras; en las Biblias en inglés la palabra aparece 341 veces. Sin embargo, en las Biblias hebrea y griega aparece la palabra Misericordia como 454 y también se traduce como "bondad", "bondad amorosa", "favor", "compasión" y "compasión". La primera vez que aparecen en la Biblia es en el Libro de Génesis 19:19, "Tu siervo ha encontrado favor en tus ojos, y me has

**mostrado gran misericordia al perdonarme la vida."**

Hemos oído en el Salmo: "Da gracias al Señor porque es bueno, su amor es eterno. Que la casa de Israel diga: «Su misericordia perdura para siempre». Este día celebramos la riqueza, el significado, la participación y la aplicación de la misericordia de Dios hacia nosotros. Hoy clamamos con Santo Tomás: "Señor mío y Dios mío" (Jn 20:28). Este es el día que el Señor ha hecho. Para entender el significado de la misericordia, ayudará examinar su etimología. Nuestra palabra inglesa, mercy, se remonta al latín: misericordia, que está compuesta por dos palabras. "Cordia" significa corazón. La primera parte, "miseria", se refiere al sufrimiento. La misericordia, entonces, significa tener un corazón por quienes sufren o, más precisamente, tener un corazón dispuesto a sufrir por los demás. El mensaje que se dio a Santa Faustina fue: "Deseo que la Fiesta de la Misericordia sea un refugio y refugio para todas las almas, y especialmente para los pecadores pobres. En ese día se abren las profundidades mismas de mi tierna misericordia. Derramo todo un océano de gracias sobre aquellas almas que se acercan a la fuente de Mi misericordia. El alma que vaya a confesarse y reciba la Sagrada Comunión obtendrá el perdón completo de los pecados y el castigo. En ese día se abren todas las compuertas divinas por las que fluyen las gracias." Las lecturas de hoy revelan ese tipo de corazón en Cristo y en sus seguidores. Cuando Jesús se apareció a sus discípulos aquella primera Pascua, dijo: «La paz sea contigo». Como puedes imaginar, ese saludo significaba más que un "hola" o un "buenos días". Jesús, de hecho, deseaba comunicarles algo de enorme valor. La paz que Jesús consiguió para nosotros le costó su sangre, su propia vida. Además de su paz, Jesús dice: "Recibid el Espíritu Santo. Cuyos pecados perdona que les perdone..." A sus apóstoles Jesús comunica al Espíritu Santo con el poder de liberar a los hombres de sus pecados. Esa libertad o absolución llega a través del Sacramento de la Reconciliación. Conectemonos las Escrituras con la fiesta de hoy: Por las propias palabras de Jesús, los rayos indican la Sangre y el Agua que brotaron de su corazón cuando fue atravesado en la Cruz. Jesús dijo que el Agua es lo que hace las almas justas y la Sangre es la vida de las almas. Así que podemos ver que el Agua lava nuestros pecados, igual que en el Bautismo o la Confesión, y que la Sangre nos da vida, igual que en la Sagrada Comunión. Recuerda cuando Jesús dijo: "Amén, amén, os digo que, a menos que comáis la carne del Hijo del Hombre y bebáis su sangre, no tenéis vida dentro de vosotros. La hermosa oración en la parte inferior de la imagen dice: "Jesús, confío en Ti..." Como resumió la Madre Teresa: «Si oramos, creemos; si creemos, amaremos; Si amamos, serviremos. Solo entonces pusimos en práctica nuestro amor por Dios."

## MEDITACION DEL ARZOBISPO GUSTAVO



Somos un pueblo marcado por la unción. Los primeros misioneros llegaron a esta tierra hace tres siglos. Entre ellos estaba el venerable fraile Antonio Margil de Jesús. Caminaba por esta misma tierra. Y este año, conmemoramos 300 años desde su muerte. Desde esos comienzos hasta la arquidiócesis, hoy en día una cosa no ha cambiado: hemos sido ungidos, generación tras generación, para la misma mis-

ión. Hace un año, nos reunimos mientras el Papa Francisco yacía gravemente enfermo, cerca de su partida definitiva hacia la casa del Padre. Su voz se había vuelto débil, pero su testigo ardía con el mismo chrismo de alegría que había proclamado durante años. Ahora el Papa León XIV camina entre nosotros, y sus primeras palabras al mundo fueron palabras de Pascua: "La paz sea contigo... paz desarmada y desarmante, humilde y perseverante." Una paz que esperamos con ansias. Del sufrimiento a la resurrección, de un pastor a otro: este es precisamente el ritmo de la Semana Santa, el ritmo sellado por aceite en nuestra propia carne y alma. Santísima Madre de Guadalupe - tú que estabas en este hemisferio antes de que existieran nuestras instituciones, que llevaste en ti al Ungido Mismo - obtén para nosotros la gracia de permanecer fragantes, derramados, sin miedo.

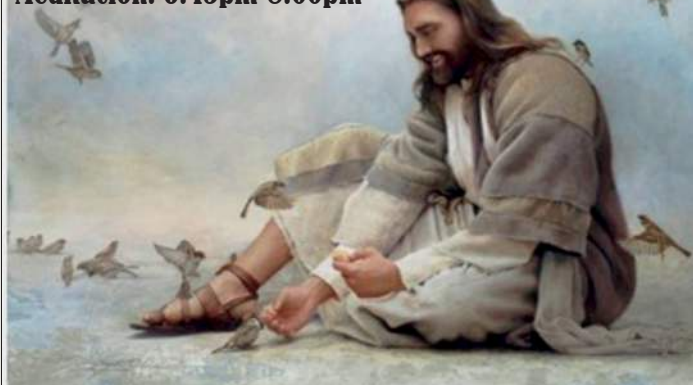
