Reflection on Today's Gospel Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

He was amazed at their lack of faith. (Mark 6:6)

This quote from the Gospel of Mark is Jesus' response to the doubtful reaction from those living in His native place who knew Jesus before the start of His public ministry. They are distracted by their opinion that Jesus is an ordinary man known to them, so they distrust His wisdom and ability to heal and perform miracles.

Sacred scripture often provides an opportunity to apply Christ's lessons in our own lives and examine our faith in response to the Word of God. Are we so accustomed to receiving the Eucharist and worshiping in our parish church that we have lost sight of the miraculous gift of receiving the Body of Christ? Do we acknowledge the small miracles occurring in daily life and thank God for our many blessings?

As Americans, do we cherish and give thanks for the freedom of religion which has been safeguarded in the First Amendment to the Constitution of the United States since 1791? It is timely to reflect upon our faith and freedom of religion as we just celebrated the Independence Day national holiday.

As Catholics, the source and summit of our life and faith is the Eucharist. We are called to become what we receive. The gift of God's grace continually transforms us and calls us to draw strength from the Eucharist. We then glorify God by living in service to God and others.

Catholics from throughout the United States are invited to gather soon in Indianapolis for five days of prayer, conferences, Confession, Adoration and Mass during the 10th Eucharistic Congress—the first to occur in 83 years. This Eucharistic Congress, beginning on July 17th, is a present-day response to Jesus' call so that we might grow in holiness through a strengthening of the theological virtues of faith, hope and love as we encounter Jesus' mercy and forgiveness in the Sacraments and most especially in the Blessed Sacrament. Let's pray for our Church to grow in holiness, unity, peace and faith.


