Dear Parish Family,

On this Fifth Sunday of Ordinary Time, we gather, as we always do, to **encounter** our Living God in the midst of our celebration of the Mass. Yes, that is our purpose and our goal every time we gather to break open God's word and share the Eucharistic meal. We do not come expecting to "get something out of it," but rather expecting to meet someone, namely Jesus. Today's scriptures speak of miraculous encounters Isaiah and Simon had with God and how they were changed by them.

For reasons known only to God, God chooses to reveal Himself enthroned in the glory of heaven to Isaiah. The scene is overwhelming – the angels' cries shake the archway of the smoke-filled temple and resound throughout heaven and earth! The vision leaves no doubt that this is the Omnipotent One, the God who has no rival or equal. What effect does this have on Isaiah? He experiences the true fear of the Lord – awe and wonder at God's holiness. More importantly, in the light of God's holiness, he becomes aware of his own sinfulness, *"Woe is me, I am doomed! For I am a man of unclean lips, living among a people of unclean lips."*

God does not call the worthy, but makes worthy those He has called by His mercy. The ember from the altar purges the unclean lips of Isaiah and God's mercy is transformative in Isaiah's nature. When the Lord asks for an apostle, one to be sent, Isaiah eagerly volunteers, *"Here I am.... send me!"*

Simon has a parallel encounter with God in the gospel. Jesus' first request to use his boat as an ambo is easy and Simon readily complies. Jesus teaches much about the Father and the Kingdom to all, including these tired fishermen of Galilee. Jesus' second request to lower the nets for a catch gives Simon reason to pause. Jesus may be wise in the ways of the Kingdom, but Simon knows fishing in these waters! The miraculous catch that ensued leaves Simon speechless. He has had an encounter with the living God and his reaction is like that of Isaiah, *"Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man."* Also like Isaiah's, Simon's encounter with the mercy of God is transformative. Jesus will make of him, a fisher of men – an apostle.

"Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts!" The Church prays this exaltation at EVERY MASS. She does to call to mind that our voices blend with the Seraphim who are praying these words in the forever "now" of heaven. It calls to mind that what is about to happen, what is happening as we pray, is a miraculous encounter with the living God. Heaven is opened and our earthly sacrifice is raised to heaven. We should always, enthusiastically join our voices with the Seraphim and all the other angels depicted on the ceiling of Holy Rosary in praise of our God. Our God is good.
