The 2020 Diocesan Rosary Congress begins with an opening Mass at the Cathedral or Our Lady of Victoria on Sunday, October 4<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m. The Mass will be livestreamed at <a href="www.olvcatherdal.org">www.olvcatherdal.org</a>. The Congress concludes on Sunday, October 11 with the votive Mass of our Lady of Fatima.

October  $4^{th}-11^{th}$  will be a time of intense prayer by the faithful of the entire Diocese before our Eucharistic Lord using the Holy Rosary to pray for an end to the coronavirus pandemic; for hope, care, and the safety of our families; in reparation for the sin of indifference to the pain of others; and in reparation for the sins of priests and bishops in the scandals of the Church.

There will be the recitation of the Holy Rosary on:

- October 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> before Mass.
- October 7<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m. at the Zdrávas Maria Plaza.
- October 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> before Mass.

All parishioners are invited and are also encouraged to privately pray the Rosary during the week of October  $4^{th} - 11^{th}$ .
