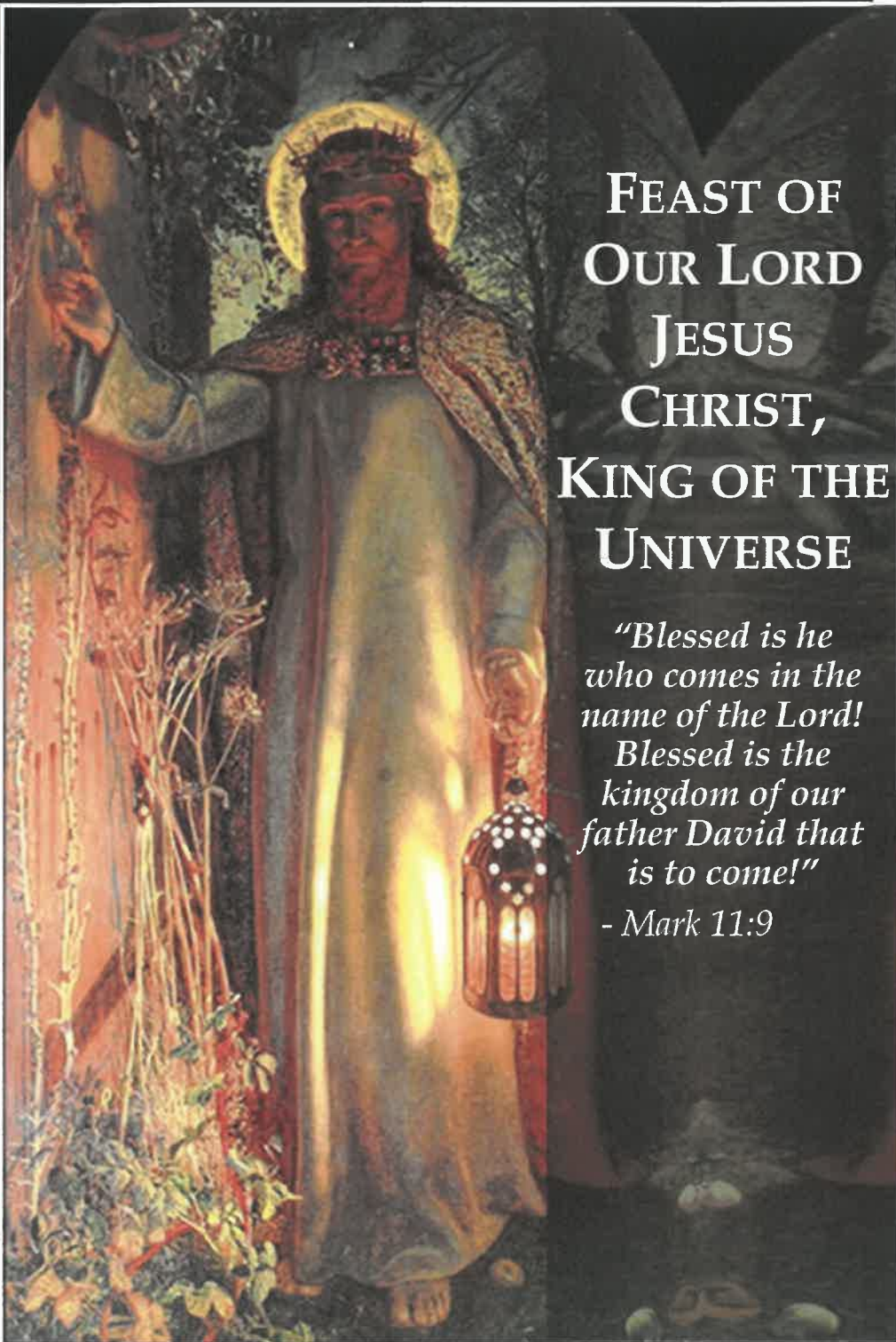

From the Pastor's Desk

Jesus of Nazareth...is so intrinsically king that the title "King" has actually become his name. 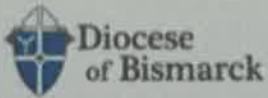

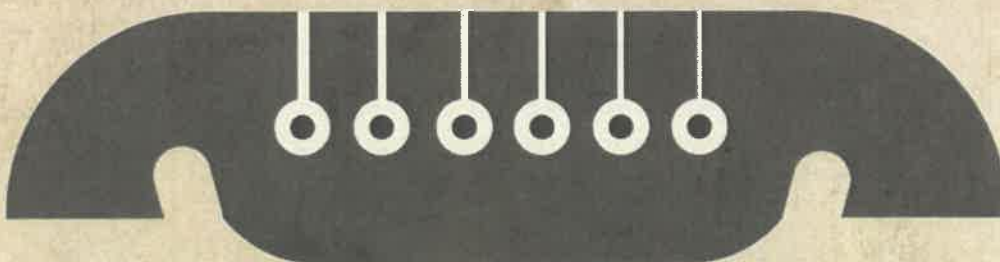

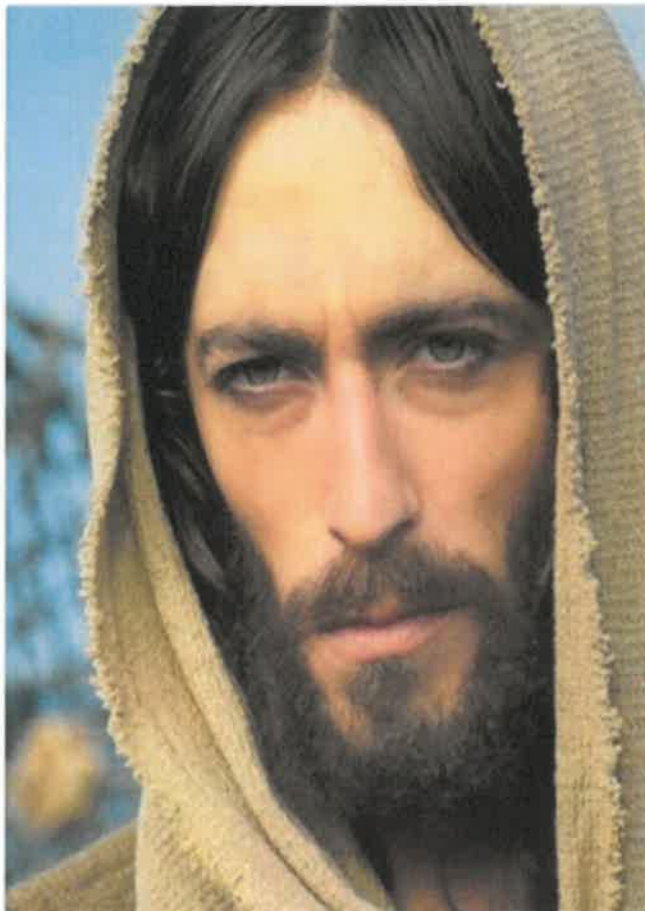
