Happy Easter!!! Easter is the greatest and the most important feast in the Church for three reasons. 1) The resurrection of Christ is the basis of our Christian faith. It is the greatest of the miracles – it proves that Jesus is God. That is why St. Paul writes: *"If Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain; and your faith is in vain"* The founder of no other religion has an empty tomb as Jesus has. 2) Easter is the guarantee of our own resurrection. Jesus assured Martha at the tomb of Lazarus: *"I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me will live even though he dies"* (Jn 11: 25-26). 3) Easter is a feast which gives us hope and encouragement in this world of pain, sorrows and tears. It reminds us that life is worth living. It is our belief in the real presence of the risen Jesus that gives meaning to our personal as well as our communal prayer, strength to fight against temptations and freedom from unnecessary worries and fears.

In a decree dated August 3, 2003, Pope John Paul II granted a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions (sacramental confession-Lenten confession meets this requirement, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father) to the faithful who, on the Second Sunday of Easter or Divine Mercy Sunday, in any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy, or who, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved on the tabernacle, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus. **On Sunday April 8th we will be having a short meditation on mercy at or around 3:00 PM following the Spanish Mass followed by singing the Divine Mercy Chaplet.**

Paschal Joy! Alleluia! Jesus is alive! "Truly, truly, I say to you, you will weep and lament, but the world will rejoice; you will be sorrowful, but your sorrow will turn into joy." (John 16:20) The mystery of Christ's resurrection can never be exhausted. This mystery of faith continues to pour hope and joy into people of good will. In fact, it is so intertwined with the mystery of Good Friday that at Mass they are one and the same. "The Mystery of Faith" the priest calls out at every Mass immediately following the words of Institution. A great mystery of sorrow and joy!

Christ is made present to us in the Holy Eucharist broken and wounded, pouring His love and life out to us in His blood so that our old self may die and we may be born anew.
