




Here is a little bit of information to celebrate the Founder of our Sister's community, the Congregation of Daughters of Mary Immaculate of Guadalupe.

## José Antonio Plancarte's

José Antonio was the tenth son of the Plancarte and Labastida family. Born in Mexico City on December 23, 1840.

He studied primary school in Guadalajara and Morelia, with great success. He won honorable mention, and continued his studies in Puebla, then he went to England to the College of St. Mary of Oscott, where he studied business. He longed to return Zamora and manage the family business. He was distinguished by his achievement, sociability, his interest in theater and music, his

people skills, leadership and especially for his love and filial piety to Mary, of which he fixed many beautiful altars.

After many struggles with his

discernment in 1862, José Antonio made the difficult decision to begin his studies in Rome to become a priest. He was ordained on the 11th of June, 1865 and returned to Mexico where he was dedicated his life to the good of his country and soon was named pastor of Jacona Michoacán.

On February 2, 1878, José Antonio Plancart - Labastida, founded the Congregation of Daughters of Mary Immaculate of Guadalupe.

The congregation was founded at a time of great upheaval in Mexico: the period of the Restored Republic, during which the reform Laws were applied, and classes were made available. Many women abandoned religious life leaving convents empty. Through the immense courage and strength given by the Holy Spirit, Jose Antonio was able to found a new Mexican religious community.

The Daughters of Mary Immaculate of Guadalupe have worked tirelessly to enhance the educational work started by this extraordinary man of God, by continuously remaining true to the charism of the educational heritage begun by José Antonio Plancarte. In addition to their missionary work, the community missions include working in hospitals and other various undertakings.


