

God alone can give us true happiness. It's useless wasting time looking for it elsewhere: in wealth, pleasure, and power.

Dear brothers and sisters,

The Body of Christ. Amen. These are two phrases which are familiar to us. We hear the first when we approach Holy Communion. The second we ourselves annunciate in response to the first.

Amen is the Aramaic word which is said in affirmation to some truth. It could be translated simply as "It is true." When spoken in the Mass it means that we believe in what was just said. When reciting Amen after the words The Body of Christ we are stating that this is truly the body, blood, soul, and divinity of Jesus Christ; what looks like bread or a wafer *is* entirely Jesus on earth as He is in heaven. A great mystery indeed: the Mystery of Faith!

Have you ever thought much about this great mystery of our faith? Many of us have been told that the bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Christ and do believe it. But for this truth to move from our mind to our heart is more difficult. We so often look upon it as an idea or teaching the Church has, but we don't apply the reality of this mystery to our daily lives. To think that the God of the universe, the God of all that is, makes Himself present to us in Holy Communion so that we can have life in abundance: this is amazing! The God who gives us time to do things, energy to rejuvenate, and houses to sleep in is the same God who makes Himself present to us in the Holy Mass. I believe we have taught our bodies this truth which is why they kneel in Mass adoring such a great mystery. Hopefully we will allow our hearts to be taught the same so that they too will kneel in adoration.

The next time you hear the words "The Body of Christ" respond with an affirmative and clear "Amen" to the truth and the Truth presented before us, namely, Jesus' body, blood, soul, and divinity, our Lord and our God.


