

From the Pastor's Desk

Last week Jesus said very emphatically: "I am the bread of life....unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day." Today, we hear the response of some his followers and they are appalled, saying: "This saying is hard, who can accept it?" Jesus' command to eat his flesh and drink his blood is indeed a tough saying, especially to a first century Jew. But Jesus said what he meant and he meant what he said. If he did not mean what he said, he would have told them so, explaining that he was just speaking symbolically or figuratively so as to prevent them from leaving. But Jesus said no such thing and he let them leave. Brothers and sisters in Christ: The Eucharist is the flesh and blood of Jesus. It is God. Knowing this, could we ever leave him?


