

### THE FORGOTTEN SACRAMENT: REVIVING ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Each of us will die one day, and for some reason we rarely ponder that day. The Church gives us the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick as a means to strengthen and heal both physically and spiritually those who are dying, or those who are in danger of death through grave illness or undergoing a serious operation. If you are elderly, or even if you are young and in good health, express your wish to your family or friends that you wish to be anointed by a priest when in danger of death. Ask for the Last Rites (in addition to Anointing) when death is certain. If you know other Catholics who may not be aware of the fruits of this Sacrament, tell them about the healing possible through its reception.

### Consecration to Mary for the Ladies of the Parish

Mary Minwegen, our DRE, will be leading a 6 week do-it-yourself retreat in preparation for Marian Consecration. This retreat is based on the popular book by Fr. Michael Gaitley, *33 Days to Morning Glory*. It offers individuals a quick and easy way to withdraw from the demands of daily life and enter into a peaceful interior reflection on their relationship with Christ in the context of Marian devotion. On Monday, November 23rd, there will be an orientation to the Consecration preparation at 6pm in O'Neill Hall. The 33-day preparation will then begin on Sunday, Nov 29th (1st Sunday of Advent) and end on January 1st, Solemnity of Mary Mother of God. If you wish to participate, you will have to purchase the book, *33 Days to Morning Glory*, and let Mary know at the office by Nov 20 that you plan on attending so she can print the companion books for those participating.

### What does it mean for a person to be consecrated to Our Lady or St. Joseph?

It basically means that you acknowledge that they are your spiritual mother/father and that you want to be like them. To show it, you entrust yourself entirely into their care so that they can help you acquire their virtues and become holy. Total consecration to Our Lady or St. Joseph means you make a formal act of filial entrustment to them so that they can take care of your spiritual well-being and lead you to God. The person who consecrates himself to Our Lady or St. Joseph wants to be as close to their spiritual mother/father as possible, to the point of resembling him/her in virtue and holiness. They in turn, will give those consecrated to them their undivided attention, protection, and guidance.

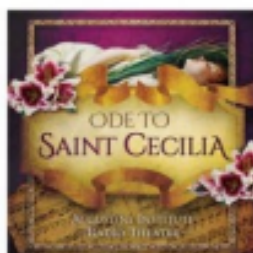
