From the Pastor's Desk


The lesson we have to learn from today's gospel hardly needs any emphasizing. We must, if we are truly Christian, forgive those who offend or injure us. NEED SOME ENCOURAGEMENT TO GO TO CONFESSION?

The "restart button" we secretly desire is the Sacrament of Reconciliation, which washes away the sins that burden us, giving us a second chance. To anyone hesitating about going to confession, Pope Francis offers some words of encouragement: "Everyone say to himself: 'When was the last time I went to confession?' And if it has been a long time, don't lose another day! Go, the priest will be good. And Jesus will be there, and Jesus is better than the priests - Jesus receives you.
