From the Pastor's Desk

Today we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord, an event which gives us the first public revelation of all the Three Persons in the Holy Trinity, and the official revelation of Jesus as the Son of God to the world by God the Father. It is described by all four Gospels and marks the beginning of Jesus' public ministry. The baptism of Jesus reminds us of our identity. It reminds us of who we are and Whose we are. By Baptism we become sons and daughters of God, brothers and sisters of Jesus, members of his Church, heirs of heaven and temples of the Holy Spirit. Jesus' baptism also reminds us to experience the presence of God within us, to acknowledge our own dignity as God's children, and to appreciate the Divine Presence in others by honoring them, loving them and serving them in all humility. It also calls us to live as children of God in thought, word and action and to lead holy and transparent Christian lives and not to desecrate our bodies (the temples of the Holy Spirit and members of Jesus' Body), by impurity, injustice, intolerance, jealousy or hatred.

North Dakota March for Life, January 29

A group of dedicated pro-life people and organizations have come together to organize a powerful pro-life event at the ND state capital on Friday, January 29 for all those unable to travel to Washington, D.C. to participate in the national March for Life.

11:00 AM—Mass at the Cathedral of the Holy Spirit with celebrant Bishop David Kagan, immediately followed by march (or drive) to the state capitol (other Bismarck parishes/high schools are having Mass at their own parish; but the Cathedral Mass is open to the general public.)

12:30 PM to 1:00 PM—Rally with program at the capitol steps

The North Dakota March for Life will take place at the state capitol in Bismarck. The centerpiece of the rally will be a moment of silence in recognition of the 62 million lives lost to abortion. Participants will stand 6 feet apart across the capitol grounds, with masks on, in silence for those who will never be heard. Use the hashtag #NDMarchforLife when sharing your photos on social media. 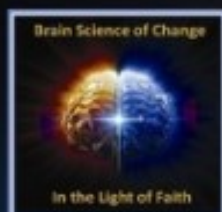

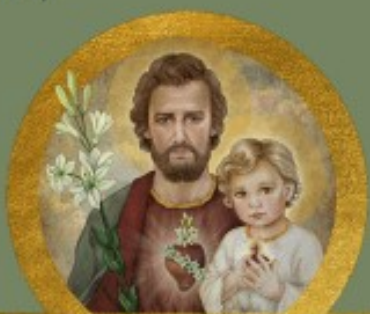
