From the Pastor's Desk

There is a deep spiritual lesson for all of us in today's gospel story. Like Bartimaeus, many in the world have been sitting by the roadside for years, not moving a foot toward their eternal destination. For many, their sole preoccupation seems to be to collect the paltry alms that this world would agree to drop in one's lap. Let's make sure that this isn't us. How often we human beings can be unaware of our spiritual blindness---we think everything in the garden is rosy and colorful when we see only the colors we want to see and are blind to the things that really matter. In the twenty centuries of our Christian history there have been some who have deliberately shut the eyes of their minds to the many calls to repentance which Jesus sent. This is a danger and a fatal mistake we can all avoid if we learn today's gospel message. For some among us today this may be Christ's last call. Will we be so utterly disinterested in our own eternal welfare as to ignore it? For all of us it is a call to put our house in order. As long as we have the breath of life in us, it is never too late to call out like Bartimaeus did, "Jesus, Son of David, have pity on me!!"

October is the month of the Rosary. Each Monday at 8:45, in October, our students will gather in the church and recite the Rosary. Everyone is invited to attend.

The fall temperatures have been pleasant in the 50's and 60's. Remember this can change quickly and we need all students to have access to their Fab 5. The Fab 5 is warm coat that zips, hat, gloves, snow pants, and snow boots.....what we call the Fab 5 at school. The weather is going to warm up again, but the snow could be back any day and we want to make sure our students have an opportunity to go outside and get fresh air.

St. Joseph's School has four positions open for the 2021-2022 school year. They are as follows:

Part-time Band Instructor. This position is for 2-3 days a week (morning or afternoon). The qualified candidate will teach beginning band to students in grades 5 – 6th.

Part-time School Counselor or Social Worker. This position is for 2 days per week. The qualified candidate will be working with our students and social/emotional issues.

Full-time Preschool teacher. This position is full-time for the All-Day Pre-K classroom. Please read the full description in this week's bulletin.

Part-time Afterschool Assistant. This position is for 3 hours per day (M-F) and follows the school calendar. This person hired for this position will assist with the Afterschool students and homework, snack, play-ground supervision, and planning indoor activities.

She worked as a chemist for DuPont before converting to Catholicism and radically restructuring her life. Leaving her career to stay home with her kids, she went on to become a writer and educator. Now a nationally-recognized author, speaker and educator on the intersection of theology and science, Dr. Stacy Trasancos is the Executive Director of the St. Philip Institute of Catechesis and Evangelization in the Diocese of Tyler, TX. She also teaches classes for Seton Hall University and is a Fellow of the Word on Fire Institute. Dr. Trasancos is author of three books on faith and science, has written numerous articles for Catholic journals and magazines, and has appeared across the nation on Catholic radio and television.

Full-Day Pre-School Teacher Needed January 1st, 2022

St. Joseph's School is seeking an energetic and experienced Preschool Teacher to join our staff. The Teacher is responsible for developing a cohesive teaching team, coordinating the curriculum, and managing the day-to-day operational activities of the classroom. Teachers must understand children's cognitive, social, emotional and physical development in order to ensure a safe and stimulating classroom environment where children are actively engaged and encouraged to succeed. The Teacher must be skilled in communicating with both children and adults in order to meet the needs of the children, effectively guide teacher assistants, and resolve parental concerns.

Key responsibilities include: coordinating and implementing educational curriculum by developing classroom activities based on developmentally appropriate practices and early learning standards; lead by example; encourage teaching team success through modeling and coaching; plan individual and group age-appropriate activities to actively engage children and encourage social, cognitive and emotional growth; maintain frequent communications with parents through informal discussions, progress reports, and parent-teacher conferences as needed; ensure a healthy classroom environment – including maintaining appropriate hygiene and cleanliness standards and safety and security of children; supervise teacher assistants and classroom volunteers to ensure they are following planned activities, hygiene and safety standards; maintain accurate records, forms and files; maintain personal professional development plan to ensure continuous quality improvement.

Qualifications include a CDA (Child Development Associate), associate or bachelor's degree in early childhood education, teaching, or related field preferred.

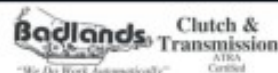
