St. Joseph's Elementary School News

On November 12 the students at St. Joseph's School will begin our journey on the "Water is Life" project. Our goal is to have the students at St. Joseph's School use their talents and gifts to raise money to send to Kenya. The money raised will be used to provide the equipment needed to filter the water so that children and families will have safe drinking water. The students will learn how the water is filtered, what life is like in Kenya, and how difficult it can be to get clean safe water. This project will be ongoing throughout the school year. We plan to be able to stay in touch with Kathy and Wes Pepple who will be giving of their time and talents over the next 3 years in Kenya.

St. Joseph's School has four positions open for the 2021-2022 school year. They are as follows:

Part-time Band Instructor. This position is for 2-3 days a week (morning or afternoon). The qualified candidate will teach beginning band to students in grades 5 – 6th.

Part-time School Counselor or Social Worker. This position is for 2 days per week. The qualified candidate will be working with our students and social/emotional issues.

Full-time Preschool teacher. This position is full-time for the All-Day Pre-K classroom. Please read the full description in this week's bulletin.

Part-time Afterschool Assistant. This position is for 3 hours per day (M-F) and follows the school calendar. This person hired for this position will assist with the Afterschool students and homework, snack, playground supervision, and planning indoor activities.


