Replica of Pietà Statue at Cathedral May 22

Five hundred years ago, Michelangelo unveiled what would come to be regarded as one of the world's greatest masterpieces of inspired art — the Pietà. Arte Divine, a worldwide distributor of the reproduction of Michelangelo's Pietà, will bring an exact replica of the original Pietà to the Cathedral of the Holy Spirit in Bismarck. This is a precise "1 to 1" marble casting that is faithful in every detail to Michelangelo's original that currently is located at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. Bishop Kagan will unveil and bless the reproduced Pietà at the Cathedral of the Holy Spirit on Saturday, May 22 at the 5 p.m. (CT) Mass. The statue will remain at the Cathedral through the summer of 2021. The faithful of the diocese, especially those who may never have the opportunity to travel to St. Peter's Basilica in Rome, are invited to come to the Cathedral to stand and pray before this divinely inspired masterwork that is Michelangelo's Pietà.

Thank you to everyone who supported our school last week during the Telethon! Our goal was to raise \$80,000 and as of today we have raised \$45,000. New Activboards will be purchased for all our classroom teachers. Donations are being accepted until the last day of school, May 27th. Gifts can be given by mailing a check to 124 6th St. W Williston, ND, bringing a check into the school, or going to www.stjschoolwilliston.com and clicking the "Support Us" button. There will be a "Telethon" donation button with instructions on how to make your gift.

Enrollment applications for the 2021-2022 school year are still being accepted for families currently enrolled as well as new families. Many of our classrooms are filling up quickly, especially in the lower elementary grades. Tuition Assistance is available for families that are needing assistance in paying for tuition. for the 2021-2022 school year:**

St. Joseph's Catholic School is a growing elementary school with a small family feel, offering preschool through 6th grade. We are looking for passionate teachers wanting to teach in a faith-based environment amidst a community with exciting growth and development. St. Joseph's offers an excellent benefit package including a retirement plan, health, life, and disability insurance, comparable starting salary, and a positive work environment! **Substantial bonus possible for the right candidate!**

The individual will be expected to teach, advocate, encourage, counsel, and witness in keeping with the beliefs and practices of the Catholic faith and teachings. Some of the duties include, but are not limited to, attending weekly Mass with the students, teaching Religion class, planning Mass and prayer services. Teachers are required to create a Christian, positive educational climate for students to learn and grow in.

Other duties will include planning, preparing and delivering instructional activities using school adopted and/or approved curriculum resources, integrating grade appropriate goals and objectives, grading assignments, administering tests to monitor students' progress, and maintaining grades on RenWeb. Together we work as a team to ensure student goals are being met. Teachers will also prepare and distribute required reports and manage student behavior by invoking approved disciplinary procedures that are prompt, thorough, competent and judicious.

All staff are required to attend and participate in school faculty meetings, committee meetings, in-services, school functions, PTO, conferences and such other professional meetings and workshops during or outside of regular school hours. A North Dakota State teaching license is required that includes earning and meeting the hours of additional training as directed by ND Department of Public Instruction Standards and Practices Board. Additional assignments may include, but not limited to, recess duty, dismissal duty, and lunchroom monitoring.

Benefits include a beginning salary that is competitive with the public school wage. A single health insurance premium is paid at 100%. The school will pay 75% of a single with dependent or family plan. Employer also pays Life and Disability Insurance. Up to 5% of gross income is contributed by the employer towards 401 (k) plan. Each teacher receives paid personal, sick, and emergency leave days. A free cafeteria lunch is provided each day. There is also a very generous 13 month pay benefit in December.

Part-time School Guidance Counselor/Social Worker - St. Joseph's School has an opening for a part-time School Guidance Counselor/Social Worker beginning in the fall of 2021-2022. Applicants are required to hold a ND Social Workers License or a ND School Guidance Counselor Certification.
