

- THE FORGOTTEN SACRAMENT: REVIVING ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Each of us will die one day, and for some reason we rarely ponder that day. The Church gives us the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick as a means to strengthen and heal both physically and spiritually those who are dying, or those who are in danger of death through grave illness or undergoing a serious operation.
