From the Pastor's Desk

Today is the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, meaning the "Body of Jesus Christ." Every time we receive the Eucharist, what are we receiving? **We are not receiving bread and wine.** Though it looks, smells, and tastes like bread and wine, it is not. **The Eucharist is Jesus Christ, who is God, the God of the universe!!!!** Through a great mystery called Transubstantiation, the bread and wine become Jesus' Body and Blood. It is the only food we will ever eat where, when we receive it worthily, meaning without any serious sin on our soul, we become what we eat. Yes, it is true that we become more and more transformed into the person of Jesus Christ. Because our God is so incredibly holy, let us never receive Jesus in the Eucharist unprepared, nonchalantly, disrespectfully, or in a disposition that would offend him.

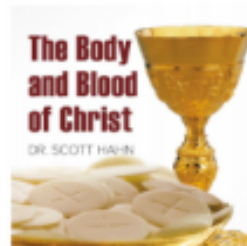

Church Attire for Summer

Modesty and dignity in apparel are not only respectful to God, but they are also beneficial to our common worship of God. Therefore, in this respect, in a special way as warm temperatures arrive, we kindly encourage wearing clothing that is not revealing or overly casual. We understand some individuals come from work and may find it difficult to change from casual attire in time for Mass. God sees the heart, so do not worry. Just make your best effort to look your best for God. For those in other situations, some helpful questions to ask are: Would I be comfortable wearing this to an audience with someone famous or someone whom I deeply respect? Would I consider wearing this to a job interview? Mass seems less extraordinary because of its weekly and daily occurrence; nonetheless, it is the most special event we can ever attend. May our Church attire reflect the dignity of the holy events we partake in at Mass!

St. Joseph School Job Openings:

1st and 6th grade teaching position is available
for the 2021-2022 school year:

St. Joseph's Catholic School is a growing elementary school with a small family feel, offering preschool through 6th grade. We are looking for passionate teachers wanting to teach in a faith-based environment amidst a community with exciting growth and development. St. Joseph's offers an excellent benefit package including a retirement plan, health, life, and disability insurance, comparable starting salary, and a positive work environment!

Substantial bonus possible for the right candidate!

The individual will be expected to teach, advocate, encourage, counsel, and witness in keeping with the beliefs and practices of the Catholic faith and teachings. Some of the duties include, but are not limited to, attending weekly Mass with the students, teaching Religion class, planning Mass and prayer services. Teachers are required to create a Christian, positive educational climate for students to learn and grow in.

Other duties will include planning, preparing and delivering instructional activities using school adopted and/or approved curriculum resources, integrating grade appropriate goals and objectives, grading assignments, administering tests to monitor students' progress, and maintaining grades on RenWeb. Together we work as a team to ensure student goals are being met. Teachers will also prepare and distribute required reports and manage student behavior by invoking approved disciplinary procedures that are prompt, thorough, competent and judicious.

All staff are required to attend and participate in school faculty meetings, committee meetings, in-services, school functions, PTO, conferences and such other professional meetings and workshops during or outside of regular school hours. A North Dakota State teaching license is required that includes earning and meeting the hours of additional training as directed by ND Department of Public Instruction Standards and Practices Board. Additional assignments may include, but not limited to, recess duty, dismissal duty, and lunchroom monitoring.

Benefits include a beginning salary that is competitive with the public school wage. A single health insurance premium is paid at 100%. The school will pay 75% of a single with dependent or family plan. Employer also pays Life and Disability Insurance. Up to 5% of gross income is contributed by the employer towards 401 (k) plan. Each teacher receives paid personal, sick, and emergency leave days. A free cafeteria lunch is provided each day. There is also a very generous 13 month pay benefit in December.
