





May our Church attire reflect the dignity of the holy events we partake in at Mass!

The individual will be expected to teach, advocate, encourage, counsel, and witness in keeping with the beliefs and practices of the Catholic faith and teachings, Some of the duties include, but are not limited to, attending weekly Mass with the students, teaching Religion class, planning Mass and prayer services. Teachers are required to create a Christian, positive educational climate for students to learn and grow in.
