From the Pastor's Desk

Today's reading from James 2 is an important reminder that suffering is not only something to be accepted but also something to be alleviated. James tells us that our faith in Jesus the Messiah should be expressed in alleviating others' suffering through works of mercy, both corporal and spiritual. In other words, professing faith in the divinity of Christ and his role as our redeemer is useless, unless we practice that faith in genuine deeds of love, mercy, forgiveness and humble service as Jesus lived and demonstrated these qualities. As Christians, we are obliged to meet the material needs of poor persons and to alleviate their sufferings. We should respond concretely to the needs and sufferings of our fellow humans. Otherwise, our faith is all talk and no action. Or as James says, "Faith of itself, if it does not have works, is dead." James is not refuting the Pauline doctrine of salvation by faith, but warns us that a lifeless or an unlive faith has no power to save (v. 14) us from judgment.
