From the Pastor's Desk

An Important Update on St. Joseph's School

Dear Parishioners,

I have now been your pastor for just over nine years. From the first year I have arrived until now, I have had many parents consistently approach me about expanding our school. We have considered a fair amount of options over these years but for a variety of reasons, none of them have panned out. Perhaps the timing and circumstances weren't just right. In light of thirty-four 1st graders registering for this school year and thus having to add a second 1st grade classroom, and with our school being up twenty students from last year, we will be facing in the very near future a crisis: insufficient classroom space. Foreseeing this likely problem, the parish has acquired over the last several years three separate lots connected to our current parish property, enabling us to more seriously consider expanding our school. At this time most of our efforts have been directed towards plans to open an early childhood center.

This exploring of possible expansion has been brought forward to the St. Joseph Finance Council, Parish Council, and School Board. From these groups there is much excitement and strong support for this possibility. I have also had an excellent visit with Bishop Kagan. As a strong advocate for Catholic education, he too is excited about our possible growth; thus, he is strongly encouraging us to pursue this expansion.

Because none of this can get off the ground without consulting and getting the approval from the City of Williston, several very good visits have already taken place with them regarding our desire for expansion. More meetings will take place in the upcoming weeks.

In regards to funding, it is my desire and goal that this would not involve putting the parish into any substantial debt or reducing any parish savings. Should we in the weeks to come be given a green light to proceed with construction, you can expect a much more detailed description of the expansion plans.

In this Year of St. Joseph things seem to be coming together very nicely: we have substantial growth in our school based on demand; we have a dedicated, professional, and highly qualified staff; and we now have space to build which is in immediate proximity to our current campus. I trust that if this is of the Holy Spirit, He will continue to guide and lead our plans. These are exciting times for quality Catholic education!!
