From the Pastor's Desk

In today's Gospel parable about the Pharisee and the tax collector, Jesus reminds us that God hears the prayers of those who approach Him in humility. God did not hear the prayer of the Pharisee because he exalted himself. His prayer was a prayer of thanksgiving that he was not as evil as other people; he announced to God his freedom from sin and detailed his fidelity in observing the prescribed fast and in giving tithes. The tax collector's prayer on the other hand, *"O God, be merciful to me, a sinner,"* was heard because he humbled himself, acknowledging his sins and requesting God's mercy. Like the Pharisee's prayer, let us never forget the two things that especially make our prayers void and of no effect: a proud sense of our own righteousness, and a contempt for others. But a humble heart is contrary to both of these.


