#### From the Pastor's Desk

Sadly however, there are many Christians who are destined for heaven but who, in their folly, have left the only road which leads there, and are now travelling in the opposite direction.

Let us take a serious look at the way we are living today. Is our behavior in our home, in our place of work, in our recreation, in our relations with God---prayers and church attendance---and with our neighbor, is it such that we would change nothing in it if we were told by God that we were to die tonight? If it is, thank God for it and let's keep it going; we are on the right road. If it is not, don't wait for God to tell us when or where we will die; he will not tell us. Put things right today, and then we shall not worry when our call to judgment comes. Death will be graduation day for the good Christian---not examination day.




