

#### From the Pastor's Desk

Today's passage in Luke puzzles a lot of people, and that is because in the Middle East, anyone who deliberately cut ties with family and social network would lose the ordinary means of making a living. Further, a person's life and family relationships were a necessity for security and identity, regardless of social position. Why was Jesus, who had been recommending that his followers love everybody --including their enemies-suddenly announcing that no one could be his disciple unless he hated his own family? Did Jesus really mean that we must "hate" those nearest and dearest to us? No, Jesus uses this very strong language as an example of Semitic hyperbole or exaggeration, spoken for effect. Matthew's gospel confirms this. "Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me; and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me; and whoever does not take up the cross and follow me is not worthy of me." (Mt 10:37-38). When Jesus said "hate your family," he was talking about spiritual detachment, the ability to put God first in all aspects of our lives, including our relationships. Without such detachment, one does not have the ability truly to follow Jesus.


#### St. Joseph's invites singers to join our parish Chorale!




