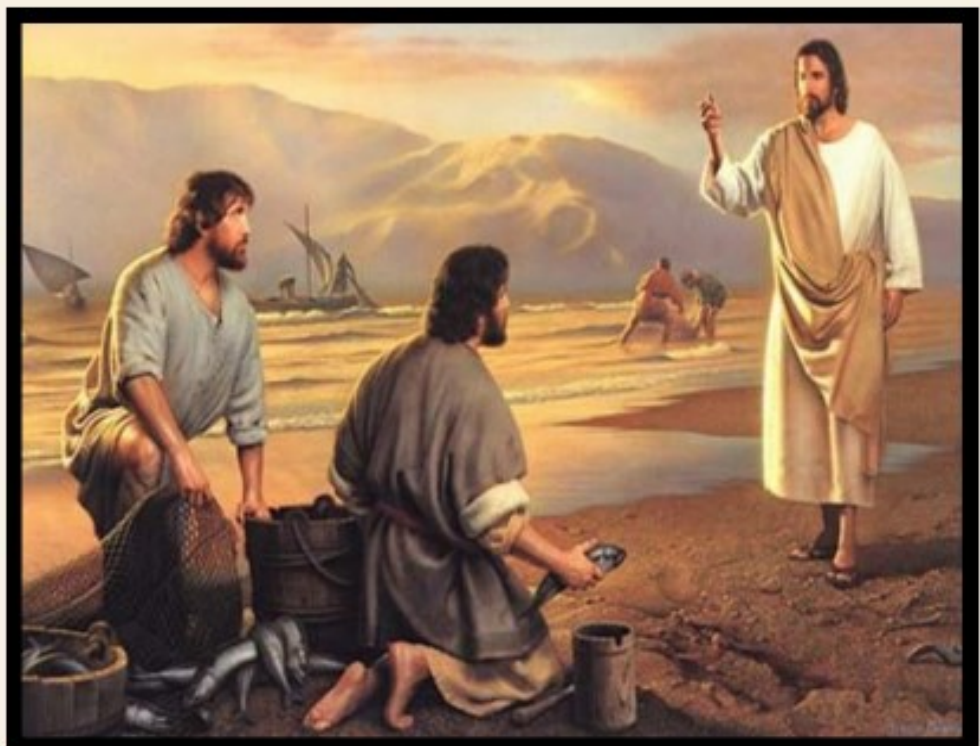

From the Pastor's Desk

Our first reading today tells us that "the people who walked in darkness have seen a great light." Before the coming of Christ ninety-eight percent of the human race lived in the darkness and hopelessness of paganism. They knew nothing of the good God who made them; they knew nothing of their real purpose in this life and did not know that there was a future life to look forward to. The two percent of Jews had a knowledge of the true God. But it was a limited knowledge and their service of him was motivated by fear rather than by love. Their belief in a future, endless life was weak in the best of them, and was not accepted at all by many.

The Incarnation (God becoming man) has changed all that. The darkness of paganism, and ignorance of the true nature of the God who created us, has been banished forever by the coming of the Great Light, the Son of God among us as man. In our Gospel today, we hear of the first men to receive the powerful influence of this Great Light. St. John Paul II said that "these men experienced the fascination of the hidden light that emanated from him, and they followed him without delay so that their path through life might shine with his brightness." Jesus the Great Light dispels our darkness and gives meaning to our lives, to our daily work, to our weariness, to our sorrow and our joy. Follow the Great Light.

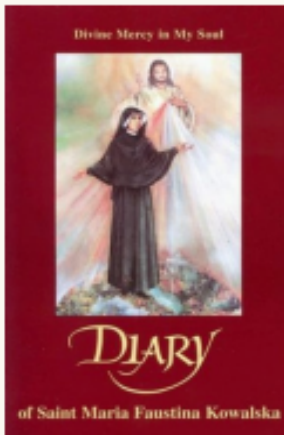

Cursillo of the Bismarck Diocese

Cursillo (pronounced *kur-see-yo*) is the Spanish word meaning "short course". Thus, Cursillos in Christianity means Short Courses in Christianity. The Retreat Phase begins on Thursday evening and the Cursillo begins on Friday and ends on Sunday. During these three days those attending live and work together listening to talks given by priests and laity. They also share the Eucharist and pray together.

The titles of the talks indicate their content: *Ideal, Habitual Grace, Laypersons in the Church, Actual Grace, Piety, Study, Sacraments, Action, Obstacles to a Life of Grace, Christianity in Action, Cursillista Beyond Cursillo, and Total Security*. Each talk is followed by a discussion period.
