From the Pastor's Desk

In today's gospel, the raising of Lazarus is the final and greatest sign of Jesus – a sign that anticipates his own resurrection from the dead. Describing this great miracle, the Church assures us that we, too, will be raised into eternal life after our battle with sin and death in this world. Thus, **resurrection hope** is the central theme of the Scripture readings for the fifth Sunday of Lent. The readings assure us that our faith in Jesus, who is "the resurrection and the life," promises our participation in the resurrection and new life. While the Gospel centers on the theme of resurrection hope, it should cause us to think about death, particularly our own death. All of us know that we will surely die, but many often foolishly think that he or she will not die any time in the near future. Let us be wise, well-prepared, and ever ready to meet our Lord with a clear conscience when the time comes. **If I took my final breath this very day, would I be ready to meet Jesus face-to-face?**
