NEED SOME ENCOURAGEMENT TO GO TO CONFESSION?

At times, we wish life provided a restart button. We make mistakes, we sin, and the consequences seem insurmountable. Indeed, they are for us, but not for God. The "restart button" we secretly desire is the Sacrament of Reconciliation, which washes away the sins that burden us, giving us a second chance. Here, Jesus, Who has felt all of our pain and guilt and borne the weight of all of our sins, yet without sin, waits for us like an understanding doctor who earnestly desires to heal his patients. Just as we regularly wash our cars and clean our homes, so, too, does our soul beg to be cleaned. Pope Francis offers some words of encouragement to anyone hesitating about going to confession: "Everyone say to himself: 'When was the last time I went to confession?' And if it has been a long time, don't lose another day! Go, the priest will be good. And Jesus will be there, and Jesus is better than the priests - Jesus receives you. He will receive you with so much love! Be courageous, and go to confession." Check the bulletin front cover for confession times at our three parishes.

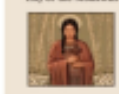
