Dear Parishioners,

In the Gospel reading for this weekend, Jesus walks on water as the disciples are being tossed about by the waves. The disciples are fearful, but Jesus is calm and spoke to them, "Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid." Peter begins to walk toward Jesus on the water and can do so while his eyes are fixed on the Lord. As soon as he takes notice of the strong wind he becomes frightened and begins to sink. Peter calls out, "Lord, save me!" Jesus immediately stretches out his hand and catches Peter, and said to him, "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?" After Jesus was in the boat with them the wind died down. This passage reminds us that while our life may feel rocked by waves, Jesus' presence brings peace and calm. Where in our life is Jesus inviting us to trust him more deeply?
