

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners.

We are certainly blessed at St. Joseph's to have a Catholic School! Christ is the center of our universe and our hearts. By the time you read this, our students will have completed a half week of school. I look forward to getting to know our school students and parents. Please pray for our youth, and faculty and staff! We are excited to have our Little Joe's Early Childhood Center opening in September. Much work has been done and the good Lord is guiding us. I look forward to the beginning of Faith Formation at the parish on Wednesday evenings. Our faith is so precious and is the most important part of our lives, by far!! Where would we be without Faith? We are grateful to help our parents pass on the gift.

One of the projects Fr. Kovash initiated before I arrived was looking into a new sound system for the Church and for O'Neill Hall. There are serious problems with the present system which was installed in the early 2000's and has basically come to the end of its life span. There is often feedback, and areas in the church in which it is difficult to hear and/ or uneven sound. The technology has advanced a great deal in a couple of decades and we believe a new system will be a tremendous improvement. The issue has been discussed among our musicians, parish members/councils, and Fr. Kovash had received a couple of estimates before I came. The proposal for the Church/O'Neill Hall sound system which seems most suitable for our needs will cost the parish approximately \$52,000. The same company we are looking into may also be able to install a paging system (PA) into our school classrooms to increase security/safety concerns highlighted in a recent safety assessment. The estimate for that project would be conservatively in the ballpark of \$15,500, but I emphasize that is a very loose estimate. They will come to give a firm estimate this fall. Please let me know of your thoughts, or if you would be interested in helping provide financial assistance for these projects. We would be very grateful and I thank you ahead of time for your generosity!


