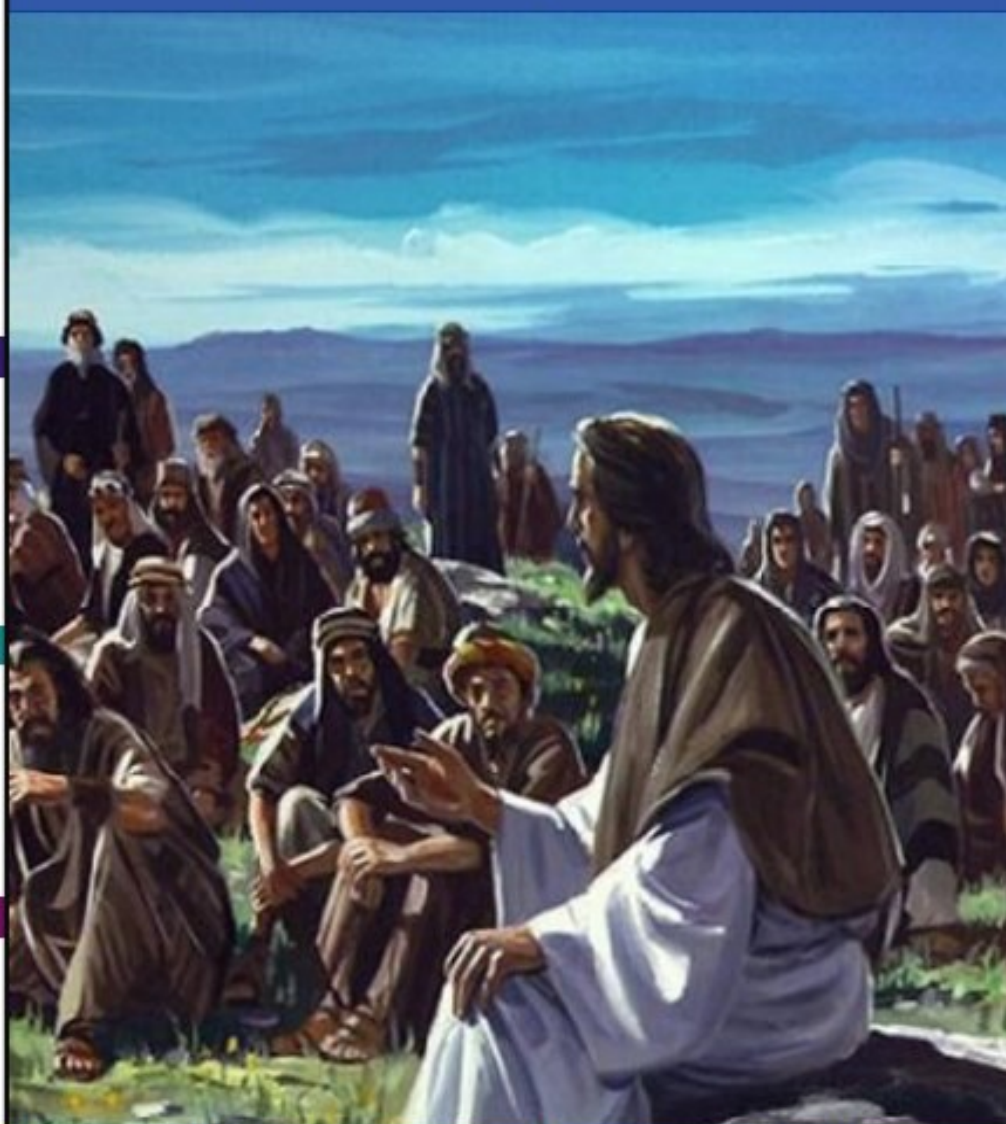

Dear Parishioners,

The psalm response for this weekend's Mass is, "If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts." What does the voice of the Lord sound like within us? 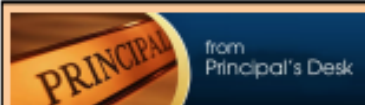

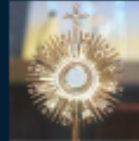
