From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

St. Paul, in his letter to the Romans, says, "None of us lives for oneself and no one dies for oneself. For if we live, we live for the Lord, and if we die, we die for the Lord; so then, whether we live or die, we are the Lord's. For this is why Christ died and came to life, that he might be Lord of both the dead and the living." To whom do we belong? We belong to the Lord, in life and in death. As St. Augustine says, "You have made us for yourself, O Lord, and our hearts are restless until they rest in you." When we find ourselves in a restless mood, frustrated about this or that within ourselves, our family, or our workplace, take a moment to gently turn your mind and soul to God and he will give you peace.

Thank you to those who have donated to the new sound system we plan to install in the church at the cost of \$52,000. Someone from the parish has pledged to match the first \$10,000 we raise. So far we have raised a few thousand. Please consider making a gift. We have also been in touch with a company that does organ repairs, since our organ needs immediate attention. The cost to make the "pedal reservoir" repair for our organ will be \$8,000. If not repaired soon, it will cause damage to the blower and make the organ unplayable and more costly to repair in the future. Please consider a donation to our organ repairs so we can continue using it and enhancing our music. In the middle of this past week one of the very large water heaters at the school was leaking and needs to be replaced immediately. The cost for a new water heater and installation will be \$10,250. Your generosity is much appreciated and the parish community thanks you!

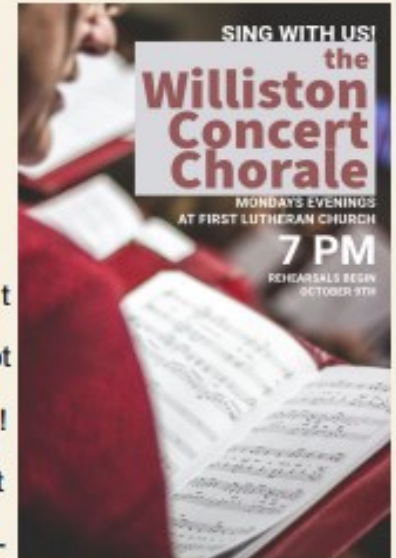

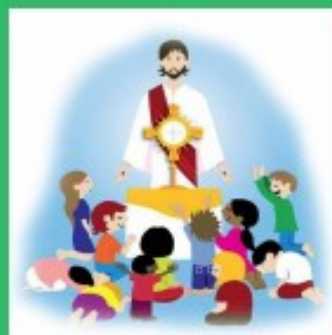
