

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners.

I would like to give you an update on our Little Joe's Early Childhood Education Center. We had hoped to begin after Labor Day, but the opening will be delayed until our licensing process is completed. At this point we do not have a definite opening date, but we are very hopeful it will be soon. We recently had a change in Directors at Little Joe's as the former Director, Cheryl Mahnke, has resigned. Our new Director, Julie Quamme, began Tuesday. Julie has been involved with the planning of Little Joe's from the beginning and we are grateful for her willingness to fill the position. Please keep Little Joe's in your prayers.

We have one opening on our St. Joe's School Board and have two nominees, Kayla Johnson and Sara Loomer, who are willing to fill the position. We will hold an election after the weekend Masses of September 9-10th. We are grateful for Kayla and Sara's willingness to serve and be up for election!

I spoke last weekend about a new sound system for the church and O'Neill Hall. This is a project Fr. Kovash began looking into before he left and we would like to follow through. The present system was installed in the early 2000's and there have been serious issues with feedback and audibility in various places throughout the church. I have heard many comments since my arrival from parishioners in support of an updated system. Our musicians, parishioners, and council members have discussed and feel it is time. The estimate is around \$52,000. Please let me know of any of your thoughts, and if you would be willing to help finance the project. It would be greatly appreciated.
