Dear Parishioners,

St. Ignatius of Loyola (1491-1556 AD) is known to have written the following prayer, "Lord Jesus, teach me to be generous. Teach me to serve as you deserve. To give and not to count the cost. To fight and not to heed the wounds. To labor and not to seek to rest. To give of myself and not to ask for a reward. Except the reward of knowing that I do your will." This beautiful prayer of generosity looks to Jesus to teach us about his own generosity shown on the cross. Jesus does not "count the cost" but gives all for us, so much does he love us. The Gospel this Sunday speaks of hearts that are hardened, but in the end chose to generously say "yes" to the will of God.
