# From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of Epiphany. The word means "manifestation" or "revelation" because the feast celebrates a "revelation" of Jesus' divinity. We recall the arrival of the wise men from the east, who followed the shining star, the sign of a new born king. On arriving they offered the child Jesus gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. These three gifts foreshadow what Jesus will do when he grows up. Gold for a king. Jesus is a king, a heavenly king. Frankincense for a priest. Jesus is a priest and the sacrifice. Myrrh for his burial. Myrrh was used to embalm a deceased body. Jesus will die for our sins, and rise on the third day, leaving the tomb empty and our hearts full of life and hope. January 6th is the traditional date of Epiphany, and the end of the Christmas season, but we celebrate Epiphany on the Sunday close to the 6th, because it is such a special feast. In much of the world, especially in eastern countries, January 6th is the "big" day Catholics celebrate and exchange gifts, recalling the gifts given to Jesus, and the gift of God's Son to the world, which is the greatest gift of all. Originally this day celebrated four different events: (1) The Baptism of the Lord at which time the Holy Spirit descending upon him in the form of a dove and the voice of the Father said "this is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased". (2) Jesus Christ's first miracle at the wedding at Cana when he changed water into wine and began his public ministry. (3) The Nativity of Christ, which is Christmas and celebrate the birth of Jesus. (4) The visitation of the Magi/Wisemen (Epiphany) who come and do him homage and give gifts. I pray that the Lord Jesus will continue to "reveal" himself to you. When you experience and show forth love and mercy, forgiveness and compassion, Jesus is showing himself to you. He stays with you each day and right now is sitting next to you. Speak to him and let him speak to you.
