From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

Each of us is called to the task of evangelization and to spread the Gospel through our actions and words. It is not as difficult as it might seem. The Gospel reading this Sunday teaches us how to go about it. Simply invite Jesus to walk into your life and then point him out to others when graces overflow upon you. Speak to others about his love for you, and live your life in union with Jesus. John the Baptist literally "watched Jesus walk by" and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God." The two disciples of John the Baptist, that is, John (the Apostle) and Andrew, hear what John says and begin to follow Jesus. Jesus notices them follow and asks "What are you looking for?" They reply, "Where are you staying?" He says, "'Come and you will see.' So they went and stayed with him that day. It was about four in the afternoon." This event was so significant that they recall the time of day it took place. Then Andrew goes off and tells his brother Simon (later names Peter by Jesus) and literally brings him to Jesus. Whom have we brought to Jesus? What is your response to Jesus' question, "What are you looking for?" I am looking for a deeper relationship with God. Jesus wants that too, and that is why he says to you, too, "Come and you will see." Lord, I want to stay with you today and every day!
