**Morning Prayer & Holy Mass with Diocesan Seminarians in the Chapel of St. Joseph at Kenrick-Glennon Seminary in St. Louis**

**Experience of the Mind:** When we arrived, we were immediately welcomed with a warm greeting by a couple of our seminarians who opened the large cast-iron wooden doors for us: Dcn. Eric Artz and Colton Steiner. They took us right away into their Chapel of St. Joseph. The chapel was one of the most beautiful chapels I had beheld during this trip! It was also pretty big. We sat all the way in the back because almost all of the pews were full of seminarians from all around the Midwest. We started off by praying Morning Prayer with them. Their chanting was amazing and calming. After Morning Prayer we had Holy Mass, and during the Consecration, I noticed that all the deacons put on their slanted stoles at the Lamb of God. Each stole was unique and personal to the deacon, and they were nice. We also prayed some of the parts in Latin, which was nice to hear even though I didn't fully understand what they were saying. It was mysterious. Fr. Wanner later explained the theology of the sacred architecture of the chapel. Everything had meaning.



**Experience of the Heart:** During Morning Prayer and Holy Mass at Kenrick, I think I paid more attention than normal. I really listened because it was a different way to experience Mass and prayer. I thought to myself that not many kids our age receive the opportunity to experience these kinds of things and get the chance to talk to seminarians like normal people.

**Experience of the Soul:** This experience helped me open up to seeing Mass and prayer in a completely different way.
