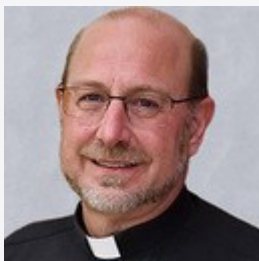

Principal's Desk

It's that time of year again and enrollment for 2024-25 school year has begun. **Enrollment is now open to any interested students.** You can go to our St. Joseph's school website

(Stjschoolwilliston.com), click on the enrollment tab and begin the reenrollment process. We've tried to make the enrollment process as easy as possible for busy parents to follow and understand.

Parents sometimes make the mistake of assuming that their child is automatically enrolled once the application is filled out. We do have to look over those applications to make sure we can provide what your child needs before we accept the application. The process may take a bit longer for applications of students that are new to St. Joe's.

I get many questions about our structure at St. Joe's. As of now for the 2024-25 school year we will have 2 kindergarten, 2 first grade, 1 second grade (possibly two depending on the demand), 2 third grade, and 2 fourth grade classrooms. All our classrooms in grades kindergarten through four are capped at 20 students.

There will be one classroom each of fifth and sixth grade. These two grades are capped at 24 students per classroom.

All our classrooms are self-contained classrooms, meaning that all the core subjects of language arts, math, science and social studies are taught by one teacher. We also offer physical education, music, and religious education for all grades. Band is offered for fifth and sixth grades. Guitar and violin lessons are offered after school.

I always like to make it clear to new families that we may not always be able to meet the behavior, social, or academic needs of prospective students. We are limited in the amount of staff with expertise that may be required for some students with more severe needs.

We pride ourselves on our small family-feel atmosphere. We have a very caring and dedicated staff that looks out for the needs of our students. Please reach out if you have any questions and act fast to secure your spot with us for the 2024-25 school year!


Queridos feligreses,

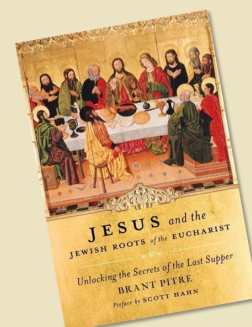
