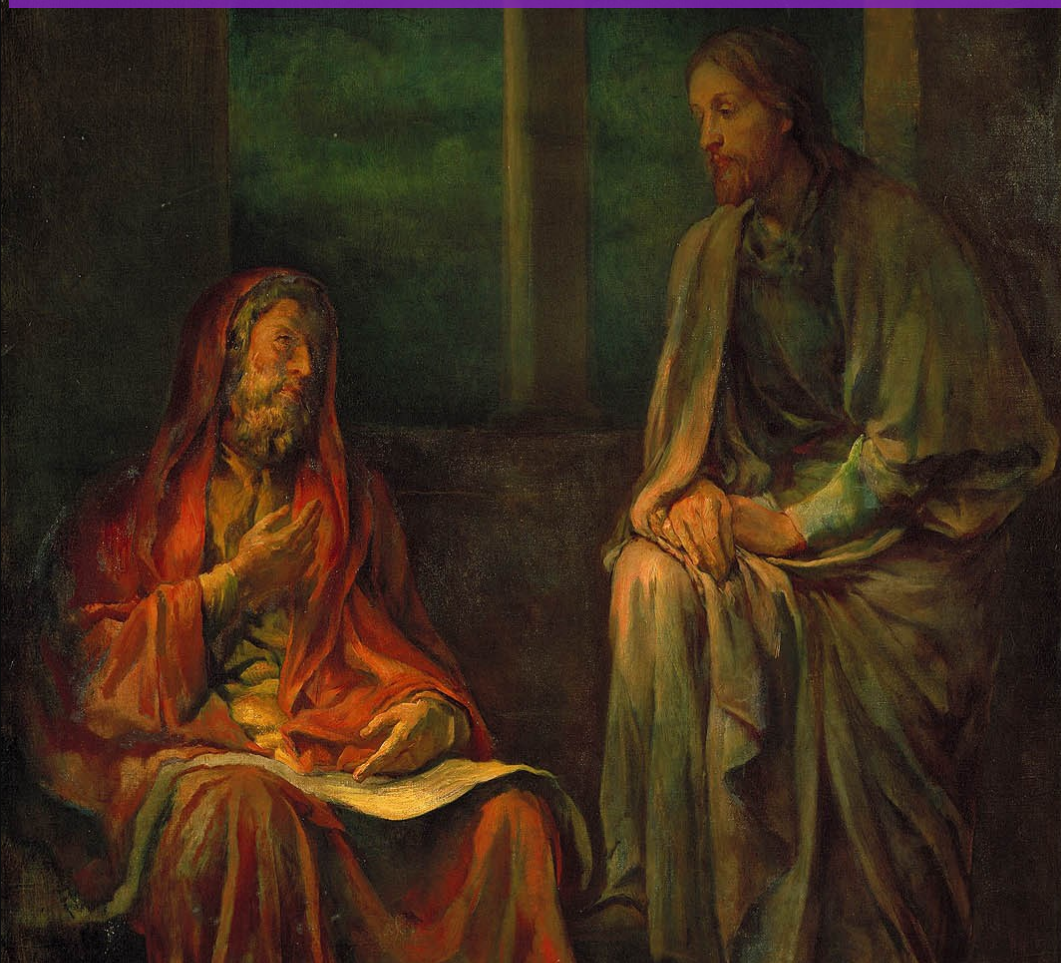

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

Jesus said to Nicodemus, "Just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the desert, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, so that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life. For God so loved the world that..." ...you know the rest of John 3:16. When we look upon Him, with faith and trust, upon the "lifted up" cross on Calvary, we too can be lifted up - raised up - as the Father raised Jesus from the dead. Have you ever taken the opportunity to gaze upon a crucifix and ponder the love Jesus shows us on the cross. He died for love of us, and to forgive our sins and bring us back into reconciliation with God. (I sincerely hope you make a grace-filled whole hearted confession this Lent, so you can experience that reconciliation and peace.) Jesus' death on the cross was a gift of love, as expressed by St. Paul in this Sunday's reading from his letter to the Ephesians, "For by grace have you been saved through faith, and this is not from you (i.e. you didn't earn it); it is a gift of God; it is not from works, so no one may boast. For we are his handiwork, created in Christ Jesus for the good works that God has prepared in advance, that we should live in them." St. Paul's words are good for us to hear and take to heart.

La muerte de Jesús en la cruz fue un regalo de amor, como lo expresó San Pablo en la lectura de este domingo de su carta a los Efesios: "Porque por gracia sois salvos por medio de la fe, y esto no viene de vosotros (es decir, no lo habéis ganado); es un don de Dios; no es de obras, por lo que nadie puede gloriarse. Porque somos hechura suya, creados en Cristo Jesús para las buenas obras que Dios ha preparado de antemano, para que vivamos en ellas." Las palabras de San Pablo son buenas para que las escuchemos y las tomemos en serio.
